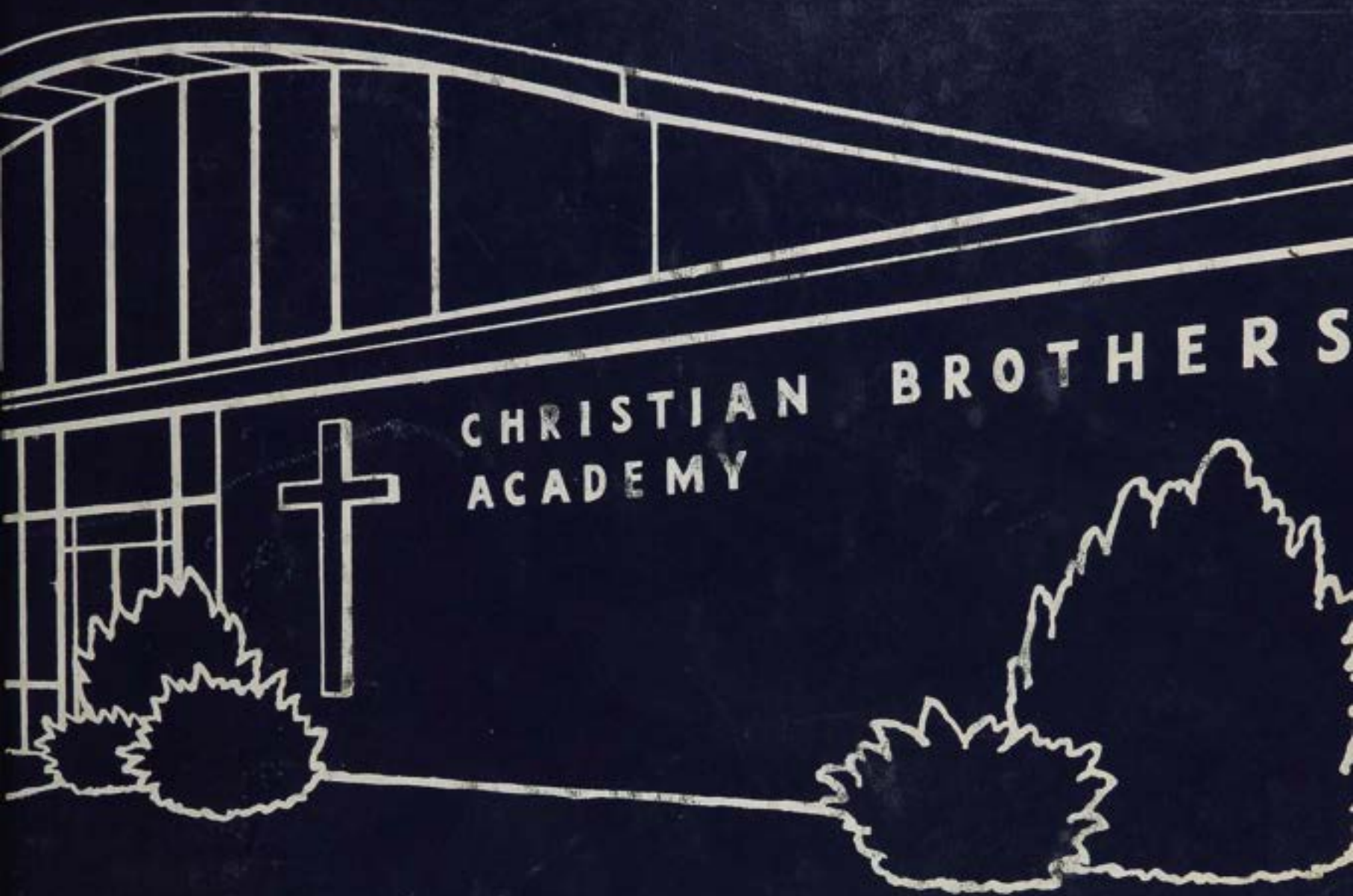

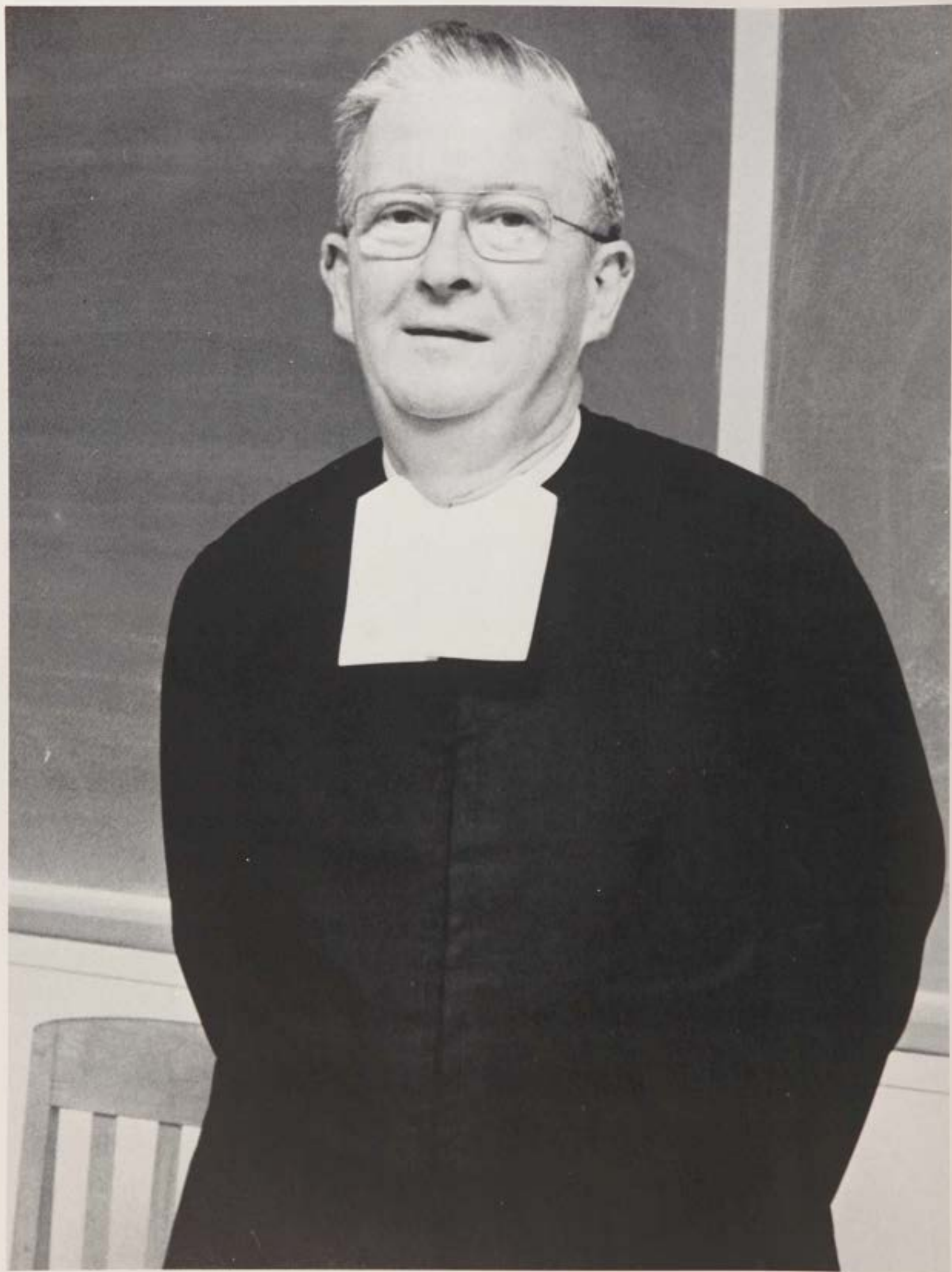

POPE PAUL VI (1963-1978)

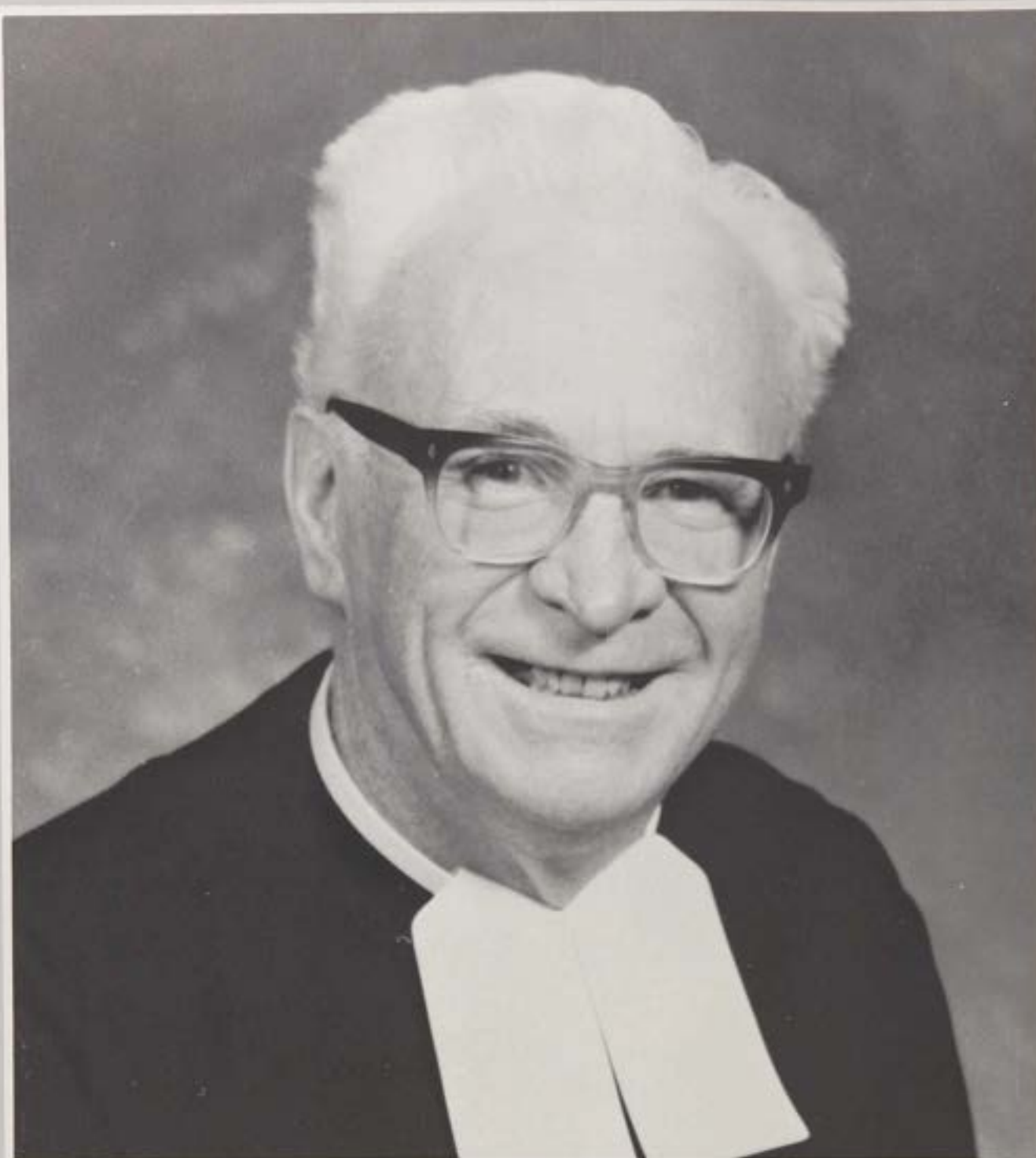
Pope Paul VI (Giovanni Battista Montini) was a remarkable man who led the Roman Catholic Church through a volatile and turbulent era. He inherited a church torn between a desire for change and a resistance to it, and did his best to compromise. Among his achievements were the conclusion of Vatican II, the implementation of its decisions, and precedent setting travels to other parts of the globe. He campaigned for world peace, and a result of this was his unforgettable plea to the U.N.: "Never again war." The greatest controversy of Paul's reign concerned his encyclical "Human Vitae". It was unfortunate that this controversy over-shadowed his profoundly new and sympathetic stance on marriage. Despite failing health in his last years Pope Paul VI continued to lead his flock. It was of ironic beauty, that at 80 years of age, he died on the feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord.

POPE JOHN PAUL I (1978)

Pope John Paul I was born Albino Luciani in Forno di Canale on October 17, 1912. He spent most of his life in northeastern Italy where he was born. Albino was ordained in 1935 and he began his vocation by teaching theology in the Gregorian Seminary in Beluno. By 1958, after having become vicar general of the diocese, he was made a bishop. Luciani was named Patriarch of Venice by Pope Paul VI in 1969, and he became a cardinal four years later. At 65 years of age, in one of the swiftest of modern papal elections, Albino Luciani became Pope John Paul I, the 263rd Supreme Pontiff of the Church. The most captivating characteristic of John Paul was his smile. John Paul was a pastor who shepherded his flock with concern, compassion, and a profound sense of the spiritual. It was a tragedy that John Paul's reign lasted only 34 days. Yet his death left us with one last message: life is a fragile thing.



BROTHER ANTHONY GRANEY (1911-1978)

Brother Anthony Graney was born in Brooklyn on January 9, 1911 and was baptized Eugene Thomas Graney. After graduation from Transfiguration School in 1925, he left home to join the Christian Brothers Preparatory Novitiate in Pocantico Hills. In 1928 Eugene Graney was officially accepted by the Christian Brothers and he was given the name Brother Arsenius Anthony. Brother Anthony's apostolate of 45 years brought him to just a few places: Holy Name in New York City, Lincolndale, LaSalle Institute in Troy, St. Patrick's in Halifax, Staten Island, Barrytown, and Lincroft. He worked as a teacher, an assistant principal, a prefect, a director, and an infirmian. Though unable to teach at C.B.A. he had worked in the library and had worked at taking attendance. Brother always had a cheerful greeting for everyone, and his benevolent work with orphans, delinquents, the sick, and those seeking knowledge shall not be forgotten.



MR. PETER E. FLEMING

Mr. Peter E. Fleming spent some years of his youth in Chicago. It was there that a Dominican priest's aid influenced him to later become involved with the Christian Brothers. Mr. Fleming spent his years actively in business until he retired, but he remained active even after retirement. Mr. Fleming was 70 years old and a substitute teacher in the Middletown school system when he was contacted by Dr. Sheehan and John Henderson. They came to him to seek his assistance in establishing a Catholic high school in Monmouth County. The Brothers of the Christian Schools, under their Provincial, Brother Anthony John Halpin, agreed to staff and finance the construction of the school. Mr. Fleming's part in founding C.B.A. was spreading the word. He had a way of persuading people to show interest in the project. Mr. Fleming always remained interested in the school, and since he thought education came through reading, the library was named for him. Mr. Fleming's concern for C.B.A. was eternally evidenced by the provision he left for it in his will.
