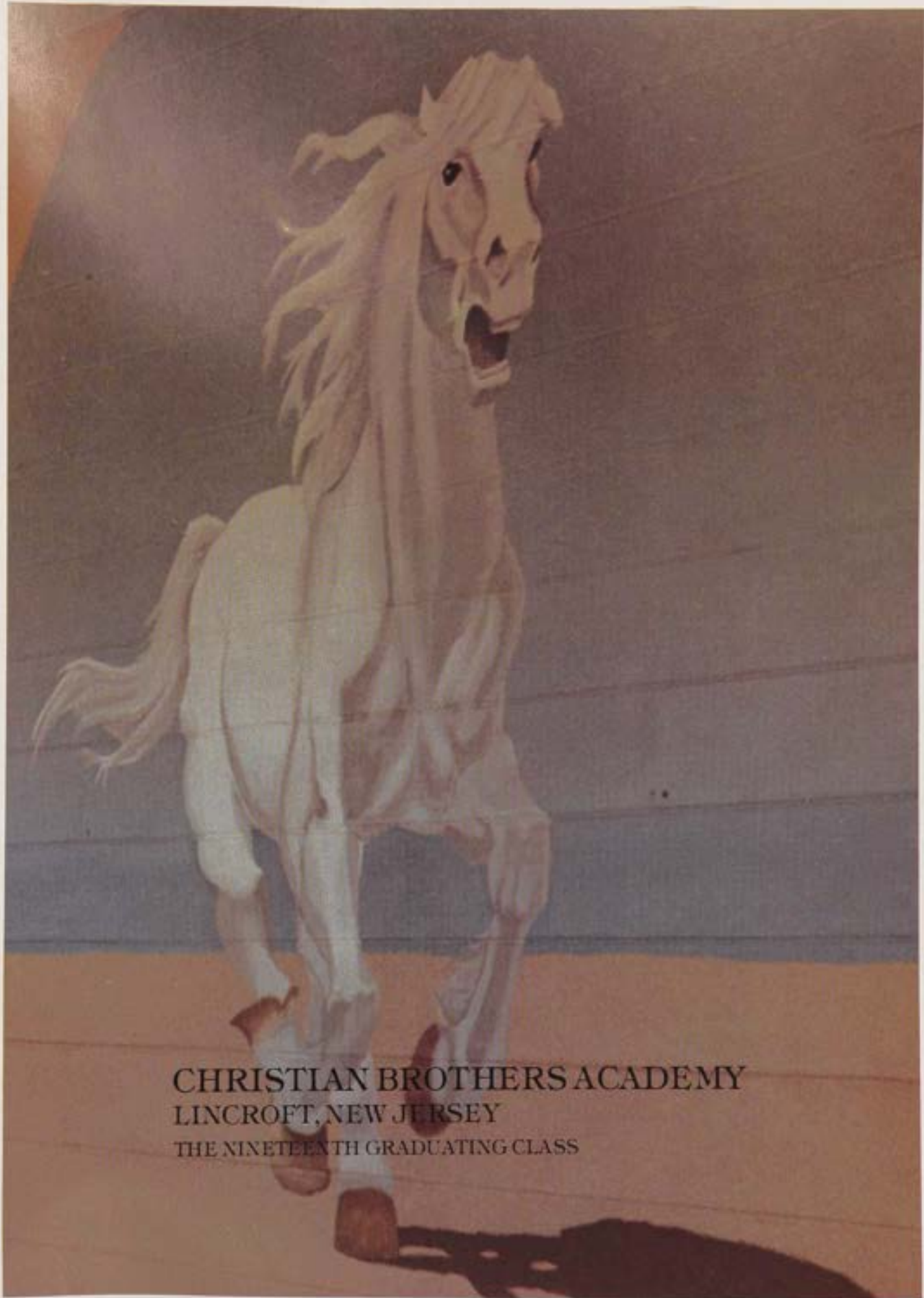

KNOWLEDGE, DEDICATION, SERVICE . . .

This year marks the 300th anniversary of the founding of the Brothers of the Christian Schools by St. John Baptist de La Salle. The tricentennial celebration began May 24, 1980 at Manhattan College with a special day of prayer and thanksgiving for the Brothers in the Metropolitan area. Various activities throughout the region are planned, and to top off the great celebration there will be a public gathering at St. Patrick's Cathedral in Manhattan in May of 1981.

The Christian Brothers are a congregation of lay religious men dedicated to Christian education and service to the poor. They take vows of chastity, obedience, and poverty, and live in simple community life.

In 1680, a young priest from Rheims, France, started an association of school teachers to conduct school for the poor children in France. This man was John Baptist de La Salle. Through his guidance and leadership, it took only four years for this small group of men to unite and form a religious community. For this he was canonized a Saint in 1900. St. John Baptist de La Salle is given the title of "Patron Saint of all Teachers."

Despite many problems and setbacks, La Salle had firmly established a new religious order of over 100 Brothers before his death in 1719. The growth has steadily continued and spread through Europe, and to the United States in 1843 with the founding of Calvert Hall College in Baltimore, Maryland. Today there are over 14,000 Christian Brothers throughout 86 countries, all over the world.

At this time the Editorial Staff of the 1981 Pegasus would like to wish the Christian Brothers a very happy anniversary, especially those Brothers here at C.B.A.

BROTHER BERNARD MCKENNA



The Editorial Staff takes great pride in dedicating the 1981 Pegasus to Brother Bernard McKenna on his Golden Jubilee as a Christian Brother. We are grateful for the many years of service Brother Bernard has given to the students here at Christian Brothers Academy. His dedication has proven to be crucial in establishing C.B.A. as one of the prestigious Catholic schools in the state.

Brother Bernard was born in Providence, Rhode Island on the 5th day of February, 1914. As a young man Brother Bernard was an outstanding student and athlete. Brother's religious training was done at the Novitiate of The Christian Brothers, which was at that time located in the Pocantico Hills in New York. On the 7th day of September, 1930, Brother received his religious habit. He furthered his studies at Manhattan College where he received his Masters Degree in English Literature.

Brother Bernard was our first principal and superior of the Brothers here at Christian Brothers Academy, from 1959 until 1965. In 1965 he left us and joined the staff at Manhattan College. In 1967 he went on to C.B.A. of Syracuse, as the superior of the Brothers' community. In 1970 Brother Bernard returned to C.B.A. where he now teaches math to Freshman.

Brother Bernard is an extremely easy person to work with. He is flexible, approachable, and willing to listen. Brother has been greatly devoted to his work over his many years of service, so to show our appreciation we dedicate the 1981 Pegasus to Brother Bernard McKenna.

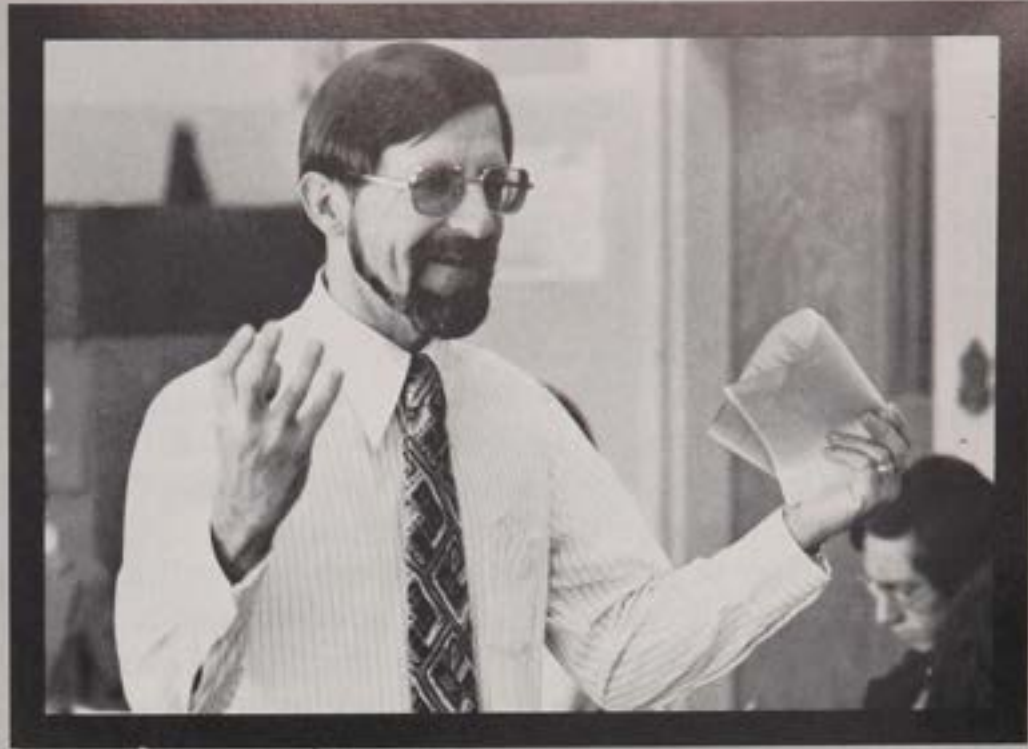




FACULTY

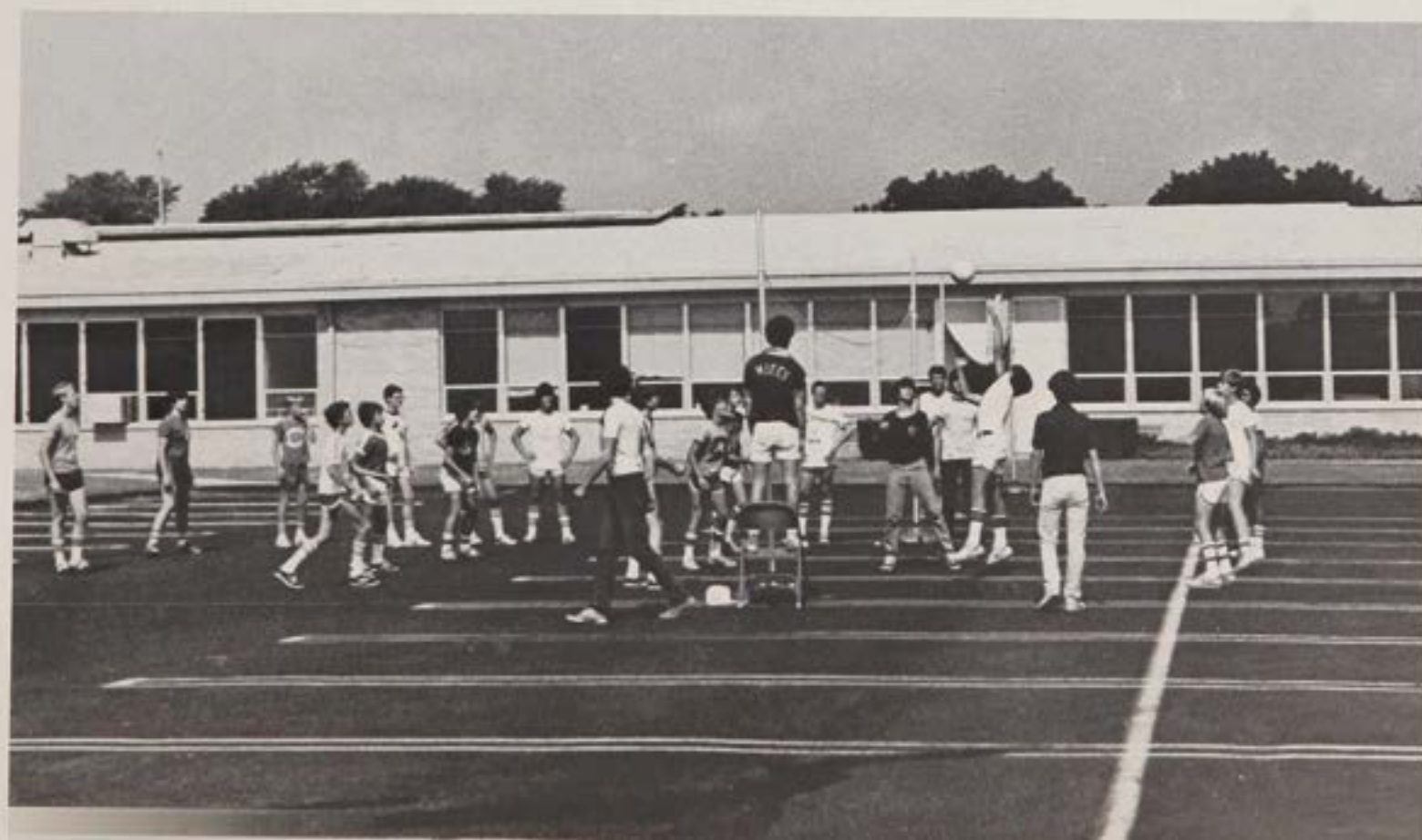
