

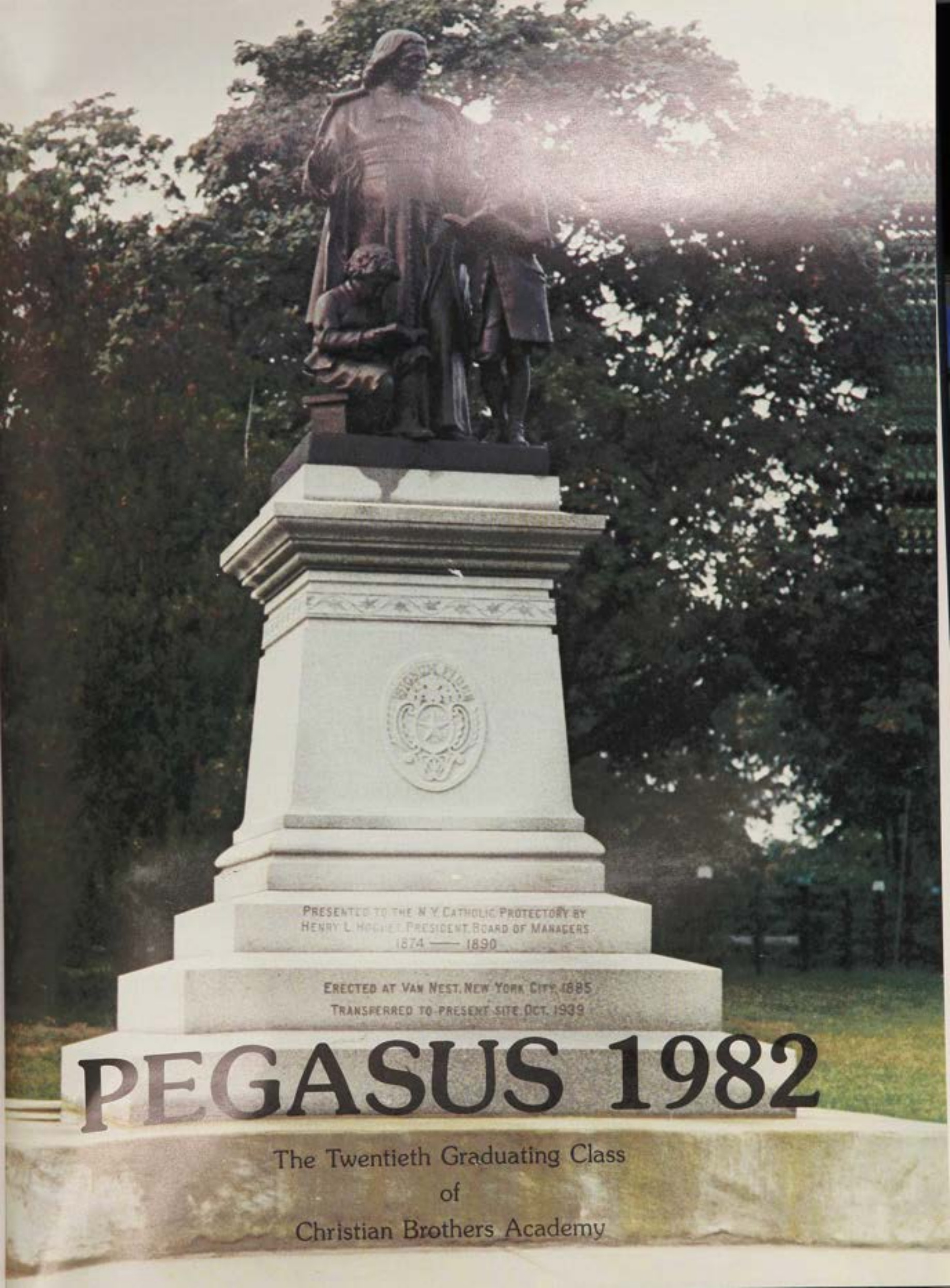

CBA's NEW LANDMARK

In the past year the landscape of C.B.A. was beautified by the addition of an inspirational statue of St. Jean Baptiste De La Salle, founder of the Christian Brothers. Thanks to Bro. Patrick Higgins, who supervised the operation and installed a beautiful garden area around the statue. This statue is a replica of a statue of De La Salle in Reims, France, the birthplace of De La Salle. It was cast in 1883 in Paris, France. At this time Jean De La Salle was Venerable De La Salle. He was not canonized until 1900.

This noble statue has great traditional and historical content. In 1885 it was given to the New York Catholic protectory in the Van Nest area of the Bronx, New York. Here, it was displayed prominently in the courtyard. The Catholic Protectory was founded in 1863 to care for the Irish orphans found in the streets after their fathers were killed in the Civil War. Later, it was converted into a home for juvenile delinquents.

In 1939, the statue was moved to Lincoln Hall, a juvenile delinquent home, in Lincolndale, New York. This move was made because the New York Catholic Protectory was closed down and a residential Housing development, Parkchester, was built on the spot.

Then, in January, 1981, the Christian Brothers left Lincoln Hall. Upon hearing this our Principal, Brother Andrew O'Gara immediately made a request to the provincialate to have the statue removed and brought to its present location in Lincroft, New Jersey.

Finally on August 16, 1981, this impressive statue arrived at C.B.A. and was placed in its present location, the third in its history. Since then it has become a point of interest in Monmouth County. Newspapers, such as the "Asbury Park Press," have published stories about it. Everyone should take the time to go up and visit the grand statue and say a little prayer that the Christian Brothers can continue their good works. It's worth the trip!

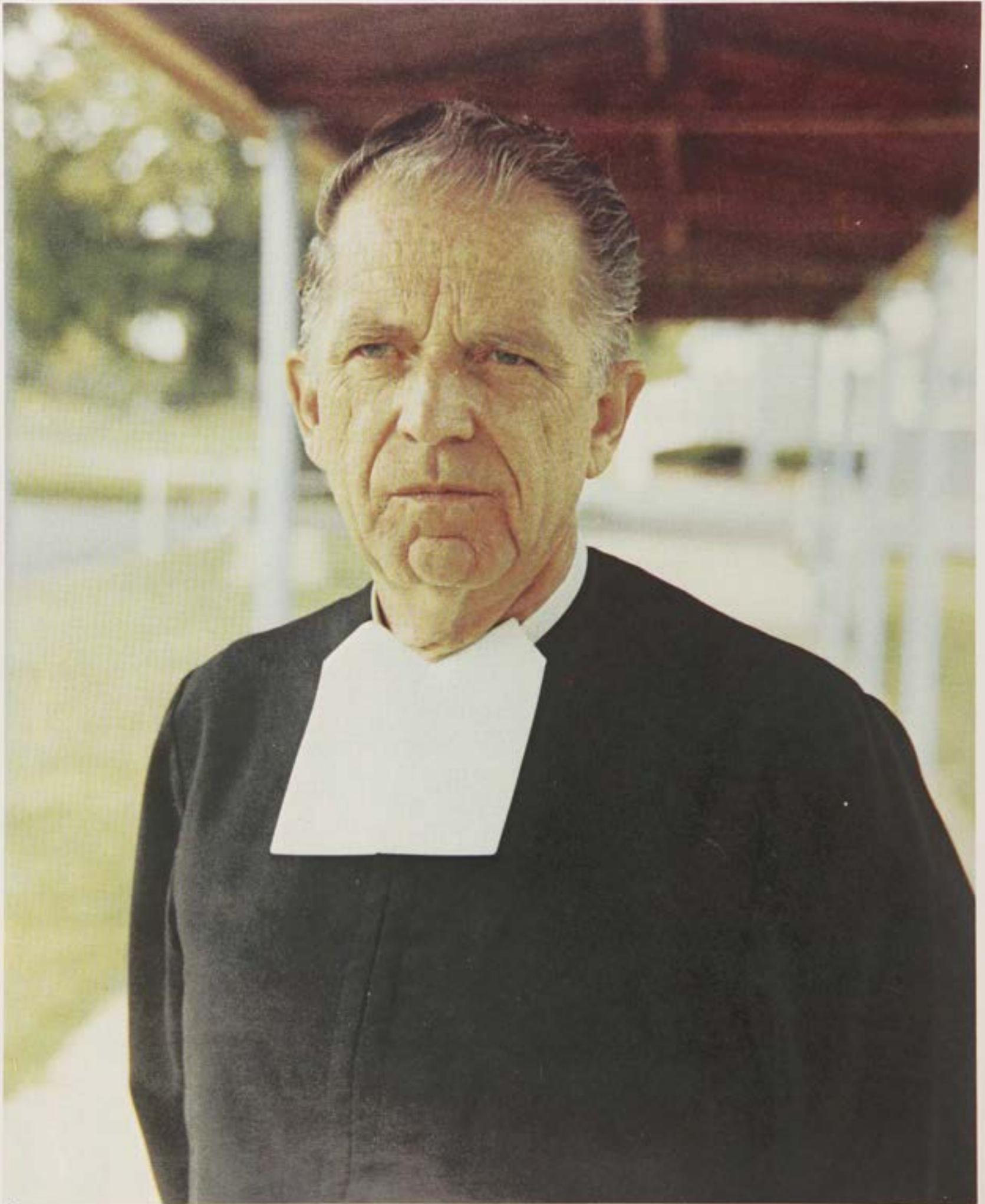
MR. CHARLES ALLOCO

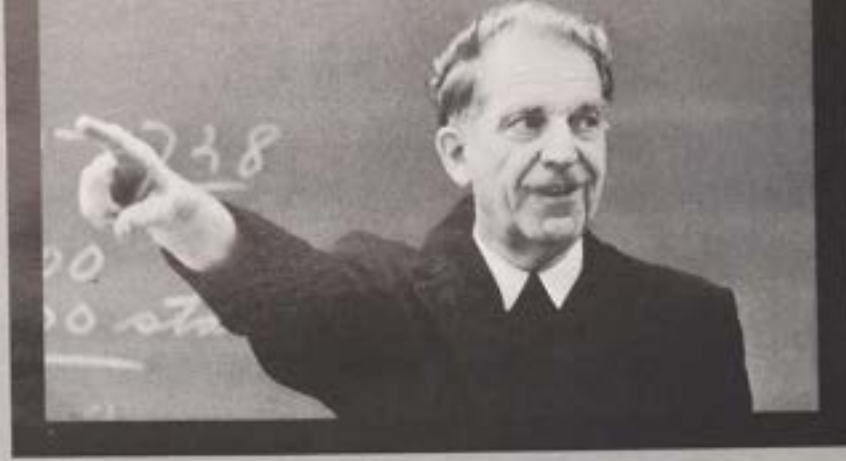


BROTHER BENEDICT BRUNETTE
