

Dedication

The twenty-fourth graduating class of Christian Brothers Academy dedicates the 1986 Pegasus to the memories of Brother Bernadine Aucoin and Father William Bohnsack.

Brother Bernadine was born in Waltham, Massachusetts as one of ten children to parents of French-Canadian descent. He attended his first two years at St. Mary's High School at Waltham, a school taught by the Christian Brothers. Brother Bernadine then transferred to St. Joseph's in Barrytown, New York, a school for those interested in joining the Brotherhood. It was at the young age of eighteen that Brother Bernadine took his vows and became a member of the Brothers of the Christian Schools.

During his teaching career, Brother Bernadine taught at eleven schools including Christian Brothers Academy at Syracuse and Lincroft. He spent eleven-years working with troubled teenagers at Lincoln Hall as well as six years as a missionary in the Philippine Islands. While here at the Academy, Brother Bernadine taught both French and Religion, was a guidance counselor and was a coach of the golf team.

Faith was never lacking in Brother Bernadine. He was an example to all of us as a faithful man of Christ. In his personal memoirs, he once wrote, "I discovered a value in myself that was owing completely to my identity as a brother."

Brother Bernadine left this world in Christ on July 14, 1985. His good-natured, easy going manner will be sorely missed by the whole C.B.A. community.

Father William Bohnsack was the pastor of St. Leo the Great Parish in Lincroft and the chaplain of De La Salle Hall. Born in Perth Amboy, Father Bohnsack was a 1959 graduate of Notre Dame, where he majored in Philosophy.

Br. Adrian's 50th Anniversary



This past September marked the Golden Anniversary of Brother Adrian O'Donnell as a Brother of the Christian Schools.

Brother Adrian was born on October 20, 1918 in New York City's "Hell's Kitchen" as James Anthony O'Donnell. He attended public school up until the eighth grade and in his Sophomore year of high school he joined the Juniorate of the Christian Brothers at St. Joseph's in Barrytown, New York.

Brother Adrian received the habit of the Christian Brothers on September 7, 1935. He attended Catholic

University of America, graduating in 1939 with high honors in French.

In September of 1939, Brother Adrian began teaching at La Salle Academy in Providence, Rhode Island. In 1949 he became Principal of St. Peter's Junior High School in Staten Island. From there Brother Adrian went to teach at St. Joseph's Collegiate in Buffalo, Bishop Laughlin High School in Brooklyn and Monsignor Tache Esole in Quebec, Canada. For the past twelve years Brother Adrian has been at the Academy, where he has taught Spanish, French, Italian and Religion. Brother Adrian has been involved in many extracurricular activities; he has coached boxing, baseball, swimming, and was President of the New York Catholic High School Athletic Association for five years.

Brother Adrian has earned master's degrees in French, Spanish, and Education from Manhattan College and New York University. He has studied foreign languages under Federal grants at the Universities of Wichita,

Texas, and Columbia, as well as in Mexican universities.

To celebrate his Golden Jubilee, A liturgy of Thanksgiving was said in Brother Adrian's honor on Saturday, October 5, 1985. It was followed by a reception and dinner.

The staff of the 1986 Pegasus wishes to acknowledge Bro. Adrian's contribution to Christian education and to thank him for his many years of unselfish service.








Women's Guild


Open House














CBA Camping Club
