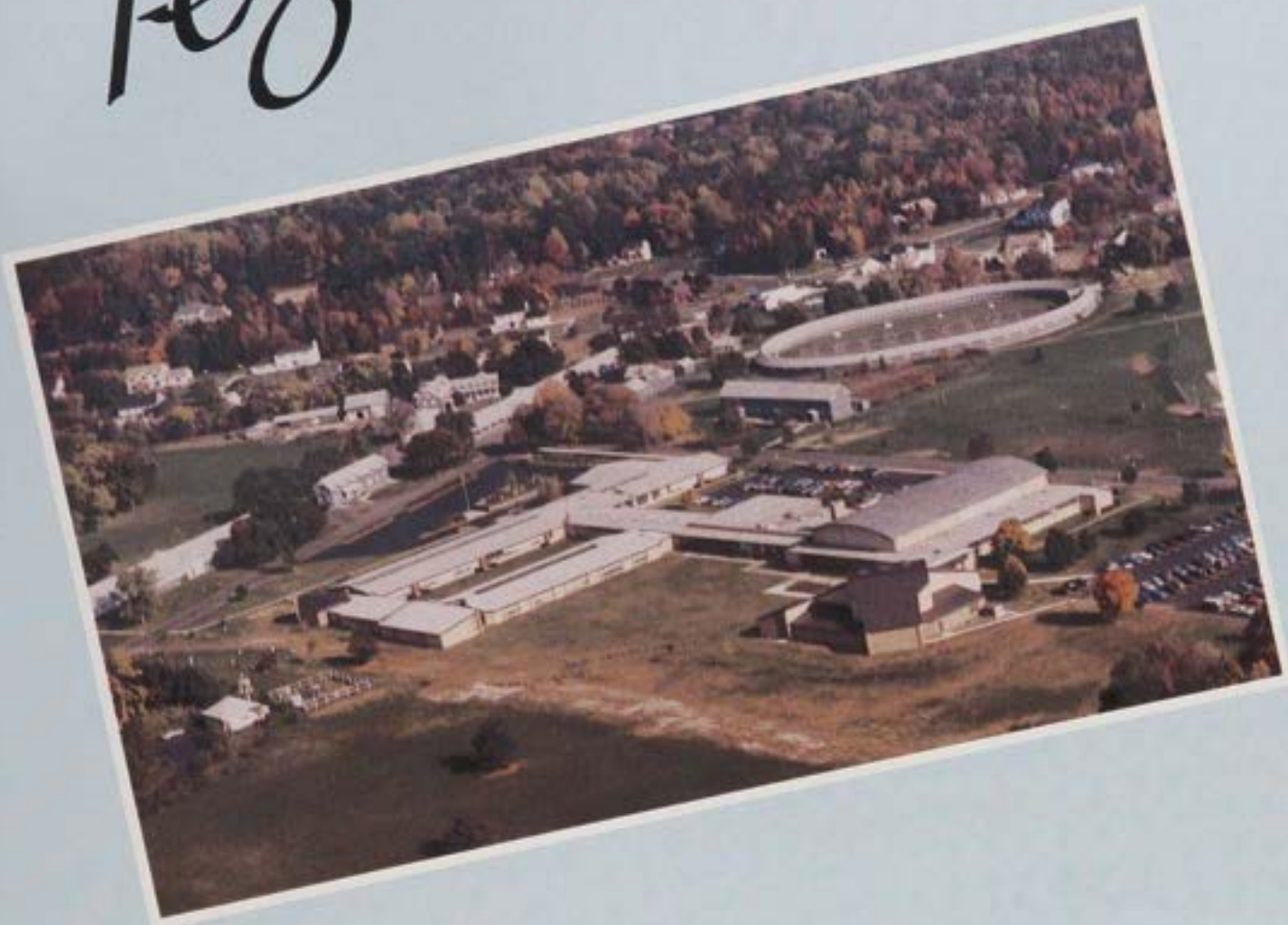

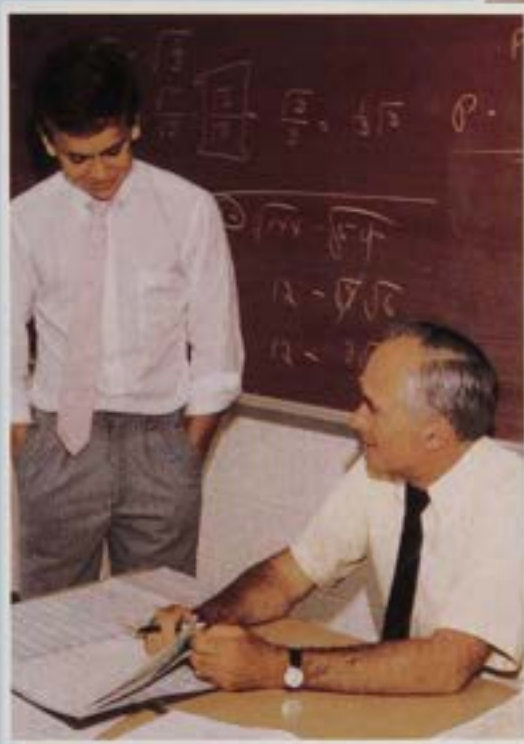
The twenty-sixth graduating class of Christian Brothers Academy is proud to dedicate this book to our principal, Brother Andrew O'Gara, F.S.C.

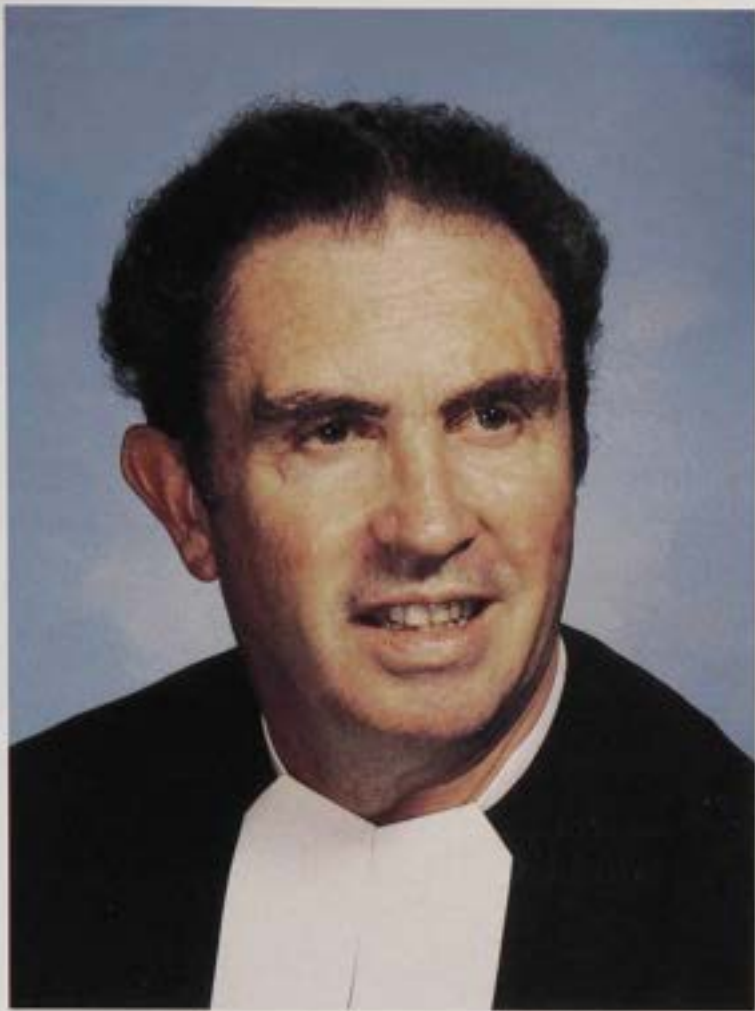
Brother Andrew O'Gara, FSC

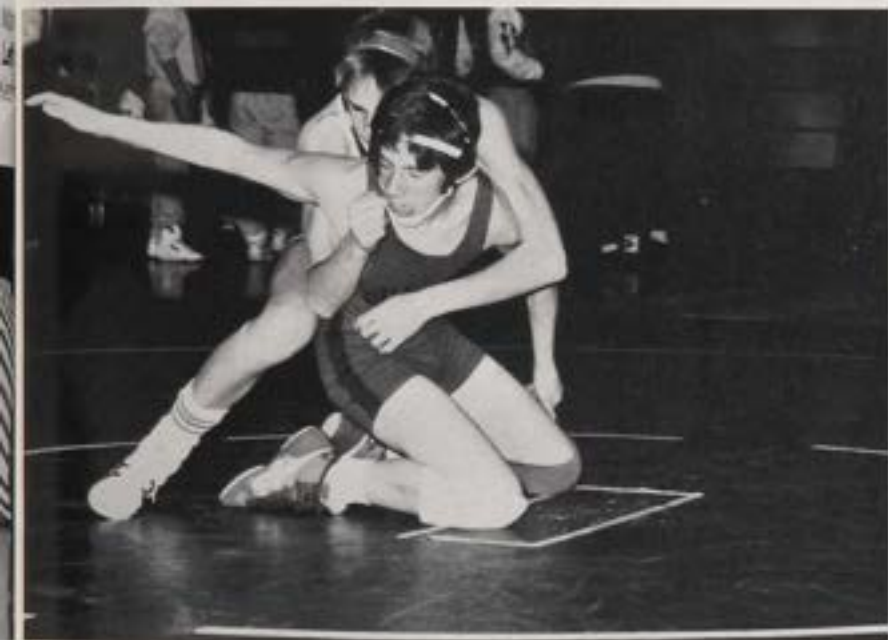

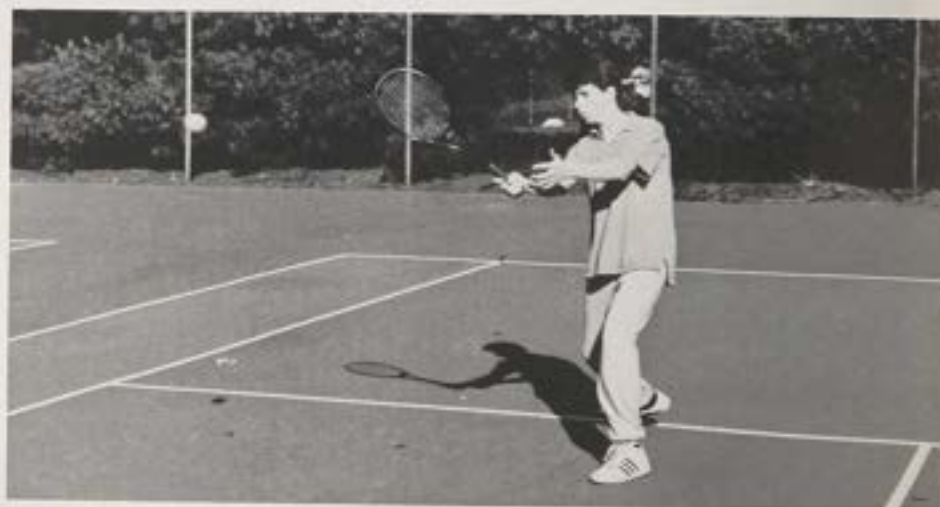

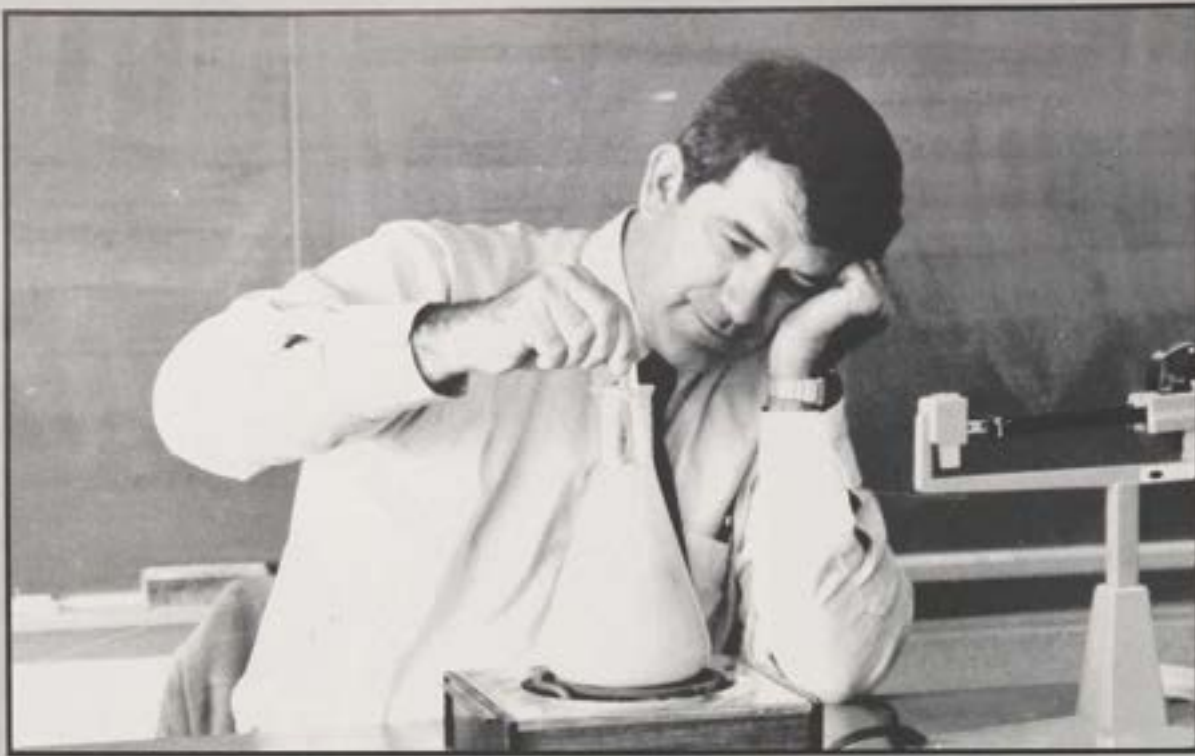

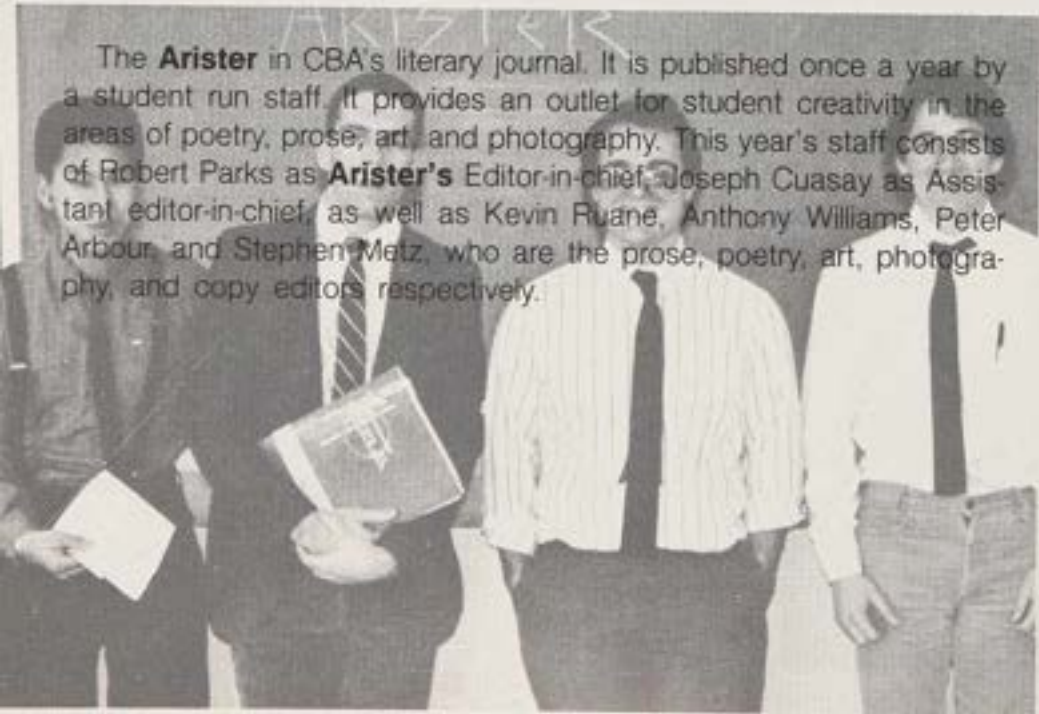

With its moderator Mr. Koch, the members run many activities such as the PREP-SAT program, in-school tutoring, and the annual Open House.

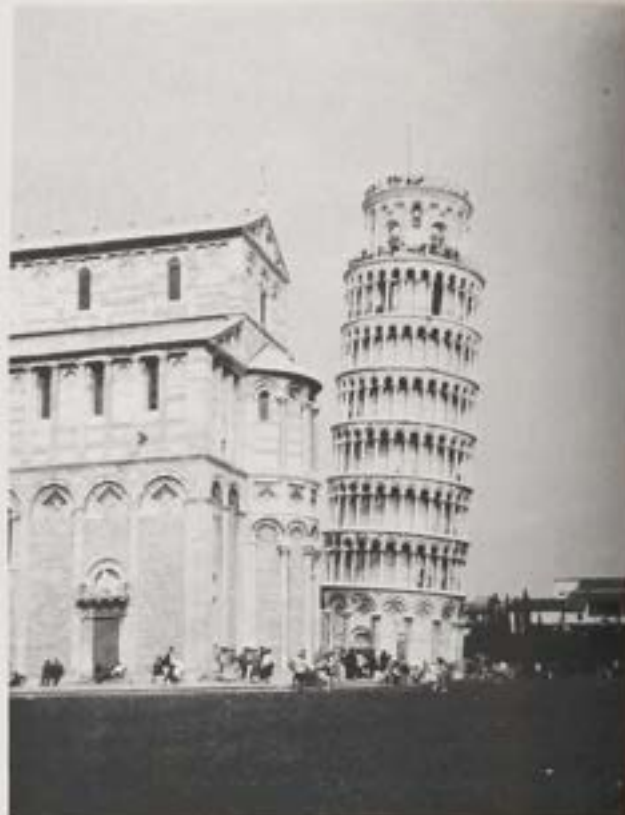
OPEN HOUSE

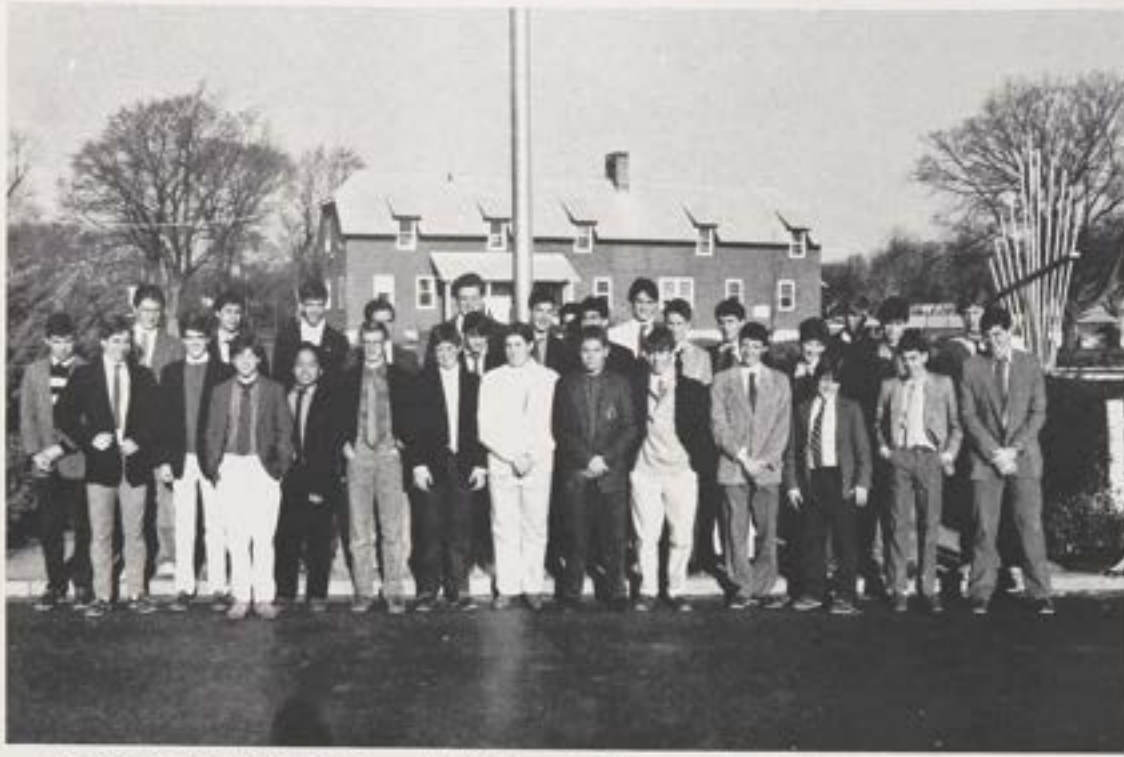

The Religious Studies department, in an effort to assist the individual freshman in the pursuit of these goals, as well as to provide a meaningful contest for their fostering positive attitudes, offers the Peer Ministry/GURU program. Though conceived by Mr. Ron Boro ten years ago, the course is still a vibrant and integral part of every freshman's experience. Through weekly group dynamics sessions, the freshmen are provided with challenging topics for discussion which are designed to assist them in their personal, social, moral, and religious development. The freshmen experience, not only the activities of the dynamic, but are also sensitized to their own self worth, and the reality that at CBA there is someone who genuinely cares about who they are and what their needs are. The twenty-two seniors who are selected as Guru's are trained in the science of group dynamics, and participate in on-going evaluation and personal growth. Those who serve must manifest the very attitudes which they are attempting to foster in the freshmen. Hopefully, the positive impact that the Guru has upon his younger peers will inspire those freshmen to serve in this same capacity when they become seniors. GURU, an acronym for Giving Us Religious Understanding, is viewed in the context of Peer Ministry, students identifying and caring for the needs of other students. Mr. Koch, who received the mantle from Mr. Boro, assists the Gurus in the preparation and evaluation of their sessions with the freshmen. The gratitude of each individual freshmen for the assistance and insights which he has shared is itself a testimony to the meaning and purpose of this program.

RETREATS

Bishop Molloy Retreat House in Jamaica, Queens provided the setting for the senior retreat. This overnight program was conducted by Father Paul Fagan and Father Paul Wierichs, a long-time friend of the CBA community. Through a series of presentations and activities, the seniors were challenged to become active living witnesses to their Christian faith in the modern world. The most dynamic experience came in the late evening as a group of recovering alcoholics and drug users shared the depth of their experiences and their road to recovery. Each senior was challenged to discover the hidden talents and aspects of his personality, and to grow to be the person God meant him to become. Here we had the opportunity to share who we are with each other, and we all came away with a deeper awareness of ourselves, our relationship to each other, and our relationship to God.
