




Father Joseph Farrell is an alumnus of the class of 1965. He tells of a classmate he spoke with more than three decades after they both graduated CBA and went their separate ways. When Father Joseph asked his old acquaintance what he remembered most about his time at CBA, the answer came back: the sense of brotherhood shared among the students.

When a student comes to CBA, he enters a place that is steeped in tradition. The legacy of John Baptist de La Salle is immediately apparent in the presence of the Brothers, in the many images of Saint La Salle, in the prayer that is prayed so many times throughout the school day: Live Jesus in our hearts, forever. But the tradition of CBA, while LaSallian in spirit and grounded in the Brothers' Institute, is not limited to that generated by the Brothers' influence. A walk down the main corridor will reveal the faces of the students who lived the tradition and passed it down organically from class to class. These students are our brothers, sons of our common *alma mater*.

Who would think that the strangers you saw around you on the first day of freshman year would be the friends you will take with you beyond graduation and college and career! But that, too, is part of the tradition of brotherhood that makes Christian Brothers Academy different and special. Our students did not all grow up together, and move through grammar school together, and come here together as is the common experience of many in local schools. CBA attracts students from Toms River to Sayreville, and from Jamesburg to the Shore. All who come here as boys, grow together and leave as young men ... and brothers.

Of what does this fraternity consist? How do so many, from so many different places and backgrounds, form bonds that can be rightly compared to that of family?

The CBA Religion Department plays an integral part in the curriculum. Freshmen take a course designed to establish a foundation of key concepts and vocabulary that will allow the student to succeed in the four year sequence of Religious Studies courses. Emphasis is placed on the student's understanding of himself in relation to the Catholic Tradition. Christian Spirituality expands the student's understanding of prayer and fosters major development in the spiritual life while Christian Morality aims to help students recognize and accept that the moral life involves a personal commitment to ongoing conversion to Christian values. Hebrew Scriptures introduces the student to the principles, techniques, and approaches of Biblical scholarship and considers the historical faith development of the Hebrew people through their sacred writings and experiences. Christian Scriptures/lesus guides the students through the books of the Christian Scriptures, examining the particular emphases of the various authors. The course situates Jesus in His cultural, political, and religious milieu and explores His significance for Christians down through the centuries. During Senior year, students have the opportunity of taking four different Religion courses. Dimensions of Catholic Life investigates Catholic belief and practice, justice and peace, morality, and lifestyles. Theological Inquiry examines Christian theology and deals with theological ethics. It is an opportunity for the student to encounter systematically the great theologians of the Christian tradition, to assess the strengths and weaknesses of theological positions, to develop his own ability to reason theologically, and to engage in verbal and written theological debate. The GURU Program responds to the command of Jesus to "love one another," by providing the vehicle for freshmen to compare their values and attitudes with those of the Gospel through weekly meetings with small groups of freshmen and their assigned Peer Minister. Christian Service Learning acknowledges the potential for learning inherent in volunteer community service. The volunteer is guided through reflection upon his service involvement as a manifestation of his Baptismal commitment.


The CBA Science Department offers a wide variety of courses at standard, honors, and Advanced Placement levels. AP courses include Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Environmental Science. In addition, students can choose from such electives as Environmental Issues, Anatomy and Physiology, Astronomy, and Marine Biology. All science classes are taught in the new science wing where students have the advantage of using computerized, "state of the art" labs. Although students are required to take only three years of science, the vast majority opt to take more, some taking as many as six science courses during their time at CBA.

The CBA Math Department offers a wide variety of courses at Standard, Honors, Accelerated, and Advanced Placement levels. An incoming freshman may start with any one of five different courses, which include Accelerated Honors Geometry-Algebra II, Honors Geometry, Standard Geometry, Honors Algebra I and Standard Algebra I. Students then proceed from Geometry-Algebra II to Trigonometry-Analysis, followed by the possibility of two years of Advanced Placement Calculus. We also offer an Advanced Placement course in Statistics to Seniors, as well as courses in Pre-Calculus, Finite, and College Algebra. In addition to all of the regular Mathematics courses, CBA also has a Varsity and a Junior Varsity Math Team, which engage in many interscholastic competitions.







The CBA Foreign Language Department offers courses in Spanish, French and Latin. Spanish and French are offered on Levels I-IV, Honors and Standard, and students also have the opportunity of taking an Advanced Placement course. From the beginning, students begin to develop the four language skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing. The students are also encouraged to see the differences and similarities between themselves and the particular worlds of the countries they are studying. Emphasis is later placed on the ability to communicate. Students are provided with the vocabulary needed to converse effectively on everyday topics. A concentration is placed on the improvement of speaking and writing skills designed in order to develop the student's proficiency in the language. Latin is offered on Levels I-IV. Emphasis is placed on increasing English vocabulary by a study of Latin root words, prefixes and suffixes. Filmstrips and other audiovisual materials are used to reveal Rome's numerous contributions to modern men in government, law, engineering, religion, and particularly literature.

All students at CBA are required to take four years of English. The freshman course provides a fundamental introduction to the responsibilities of college preparatory English work. Grammar, basic genres of literature, reading and writing are stressed. English II covers three basic areas of English education: a literary survey of American literature. exercises in expository, descriptive and argumentative prose, with emphasis upon the research essay, and studies in grammar. The third year course includes a literary survey of British literature, fundamental principles of writing research papers, and the more complex areas of grammar, syntax, vocabulary, and speech are stressed. Senior English entails the study of the major literary and philosophical works and concepts of the Western tradition and presents writing assignments in the areas of expository and argumentative prose and literary analysis. The course also stresses competency and creativity in editing, grammar, and other sophisticated linguistic skills. Those students showing a remarkable proficiency in English may take the Advanced Placement course.


In addition to the core requirements, students may choose from an array of elective courses offered by the English department. Film Study is a survey of the development of the motion picture in America and introduces students to major films and filmmakers as well as to the fundamentals of film analysis and appreciation. Journalism is a practical workshop in student journalism whose main function is to publish The Torch, CBA's student newspaper. Writing Workshop provides students with an opportunity to learn to write better by becoming members of an active, constructive community of writers and readers. Myths, Dreams and Cultures consists of the works of writers around the world who present a body of knowledge that acquaints the reader with the customs, mythologies, and literary and anthropological highlights of indigenous and non-Judeo-Christian based cultures. Humanities is an analytical and developmental study of the Fine Arts which actively involves students in the various learning experiences pertaining to aesthetics, art criticism, art history and studio production. Horror, Science Fiction, and Fantasy Literature examines works of popular and critically acclaimed writers in these genres.







The level of computer knowledge of our students differs as they enter CBA and the use of computers is expanding so rapidly, we are constantly evaluating and revising computer course content. As of the 1998-199 school year, the students at CBA are required to follow a 2 year sequence of instruction beginning in Freshmen year. In the course called 'PC Lab', they are first introduced to Microsoft Office 97 which introduces them to the Windows operating system and the applications of word processing, spreadsheets, databases, and the ability to create presentations. This is required so that the computer will be a tool to be used in all courses taken at CBA. This is followed by a half year course called 'Computer Concepts' which explains how the computer actually functions. The students get to learn about operating systems, how information is entered into the computer, how the computer processes this information and produces a satisfactory output. While studying the processes of the computer, they learn the basics of programming the computer to produce output from input.

We expect each student by sophomore year to be able to use the computer, the Internet and other locally available databases as a research tool to access and evaluate information. The computer then can become an instrument of communication and learning in all disciplines of study.

The Guidance Services are designed to assist each student in discovering and developing all his abilities, as well as learning more about his assets and limitations. The studnet is encouraged to seek information, examine alternate routes of action and assume responsibility for making his own plans and decisions.

The guidance program aims at assiting students to mature in a self-understanding, concern for others and developing values in harmony with the philosophy of CBA and the commitment of exemplary citizens in our pluralistic society.

All students are interviewed several times per year. During Group Guidance/Health sessions, study skills (Freshman year), career exploration (Sophmore year), college selection, and the college application process (Junior year) are emphasized, as well as topics including drug and alchol education (Senior year). College counselors visit Christian Brothers Academy, during the first semester of each year. Seniors expressing an interest in a particular school may meet with the college representitives during their free periods.

## La Sallian Educator Of The Year BROTHER HENRY MC GRATH


Brother Henry McGrath has been working with young people in the field of education all of his adult life. For the past fifteen years, he has been the ninth grade guidance counselor at Christian Brothers Academy, Lincroft, NJ.

He will work with any student who is willing to cooperate with him as well as work long and hard to win over students who may not necessarily be inclined toward academic excellence.





Besides being interested in the scholastic growth of the CBA student, Brother faithfully follows their athletic and cultural endeavors. He is an avid follower of the athletic teams and the intramural programs. He supports and encourages the students by his presence at all musical and drama performances.

Most students know of all the other teachers but all students know Brother Henry - - a man who makes them feel very welcomed when they first come to CBA and a man they know they can always go to if they need someone to talk to. He is extremely helpful to parents especially those who may be overly concerned about their son's adjustment to high school and their coping with the latest trends in teenager issues. Many parents feel very comfortable seeking Brother's advice in trying to understand their sons better.

Brother Henry deserves to be considered for the LaSallian Educator Award because of his firm conviction that he is contributing to the life and development of the CBA students. This is his way of sharing in the teaching mission of the Church and God's overall plan for mankind.

CBA is blessed to have two ordained men on staff: Father John Folchetti and Deacon John Fitzsimmons. They have fostered growth in an already-strong program of prayer and devotion at the Academy. Of course, Mass is celebrated with the whole community on special occasions. On Ash Wednesday there is a special service to prepare for the season of Lent. During Lent and Advent there are particular devotional observances, including communal praying of the Rosary or the Stations of the Cross. On First Fridays, the Eucharist is exposed for quiet adoration throughout the school day, culminating in Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Throughout the year, small groups, especially religion classes, will gather for special Masses or penance services.

Of course, the hidden treasure is daily morning Mass. Each day the Sacred Mysteries are celebrated in the school chapel. This year has seen an increased participation by students and parents. Everyone is called to participate fully at Mass, each according to his proper role. Some are called to serve the community as acolytes, readers, sacred musicians, sacristans, ministers of hospitality, or extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion. Students are selected to serve the community on the basis of character and desire. All who serve are charged especially with the duty to serve as witnesses to Christ in their daily lives.

The program of liturgy, para-liturgical celebrations, and communal devotions is intended to foster an evergreater personal commitment to prayer and sanctity in the lives of the individuals here at CBA.



This program is designed to help both the freshman and the senior GURUs by establishing a communal environment. All members of the group are able to share their experiences and opinions, get to know each other, and develop a sense of belonging. The senior GURUs also meet frequently in group sessions to seek a selfawareness that can be attained through reflection on their experiences within the group and in their personal lives.

### CHRISTIAN SERVICE LEARNING

The main focus in the Christian Service-Learning course is volunteer work. This class recognizes the importance of assisting the community. Each student is required to spend at least two hours each week volunteering their time and effort by working in hospital, working at latchkey, tutoring homeless children, teaching CCD classes, building homes, and teaching young children how to swim. Along with his service work, a student is expected to write about his experiences in a journal. This helps the student develop an understanding of his relationship with God and with others. In the third marking period, students give a presentation about their service work to the class. The best reports are then given to underclassmen to teach them the importance of volunteer work.


The Baccalaurate Liturgy was celebrated in the Henderson Theater. Father John was assisted by Deacon John, who read the Gospel from Mark.

















### Commencement May 18th 1999



This is the moment that four years ago we thought would never come, but we have just graduated. In fact, we have done so much more than just complete the minimum requirements for graduation. We have succeeded on all levels – spintual, academic, athletic, social – and most importantly we have received the foundation necessary for success in the future. Although we should all be congratulated for our hard work, our success would not have been possible without the guidance, support, and positive example provided by our parents and teachers. Also, we should all understand how well we are prepared for the future, even though some of us are reluctant to admit the enjoyment and value of our time at CBA.

Often at the end of special events, whether it be the end of a year, the end of a high school career, or the end of a millennium, we remember past events and hope for a better future. This is especially the case for us as the last class of the 1900's. As we look toward the future, even if it is only to the next four years of college, we should understand that we are living in a period of complete change. The near future will be a time of extended rights and toleration, increased emphasis on technology, and globalized communication and information. The trend of change is also present in all our lives at CBA. Religiously, the community service project has recently been instituted to allow students to perform their Christian duty to help others. Socially, the value-of-the-month program has been developed to teach toleration and Christian virtues. 



Change, however, does not always lead to a better future, or progress. For example, will we reflect on and implement the virtues from the values-of-themonth program, or will we simply dismiss these values as insignificant in our lives? Whether change leads to progress depends not on the specific trends of change but on how individuals, like you and me, use this change. In the words of John Kenneth Galbraith, "People are the common denominator of progress. It would be wrong to dismiss the importance of roads, railroads, power plants, mills, and the other familiar furniture of economic development, [but] no improvement is possible with unimproved people." Therefore, the goal for the future should be the environment of not only ourselves but of all people so that the change in the future will lead to progress.

Some may ask how we could possibly change a world filled with so many global problems. The answer comes in the needs to cause pogress on the local level, not the international level. CBA has prepared us for such a life, whether it be in the example of the teachers and Brothers, in school programs aimed at developing toleration, or in the most basic teachings of Jesus learned in religion class. However, this preparation can only serve as a foundation. The other aspect that is needed for a life of action based on actively seeking situations in which one can help others. These situations could be as simple as helping an elderly neighbor or as involved as choosing a career aimed specifically at helping others. As people who have been blessed with various talents and who have been given the privilege of continuing our education in college, we have the responsibility to take a role as leaders and to use our talents to improve the world by improving the individuals who make up society. We will all have decisions to make regarding how we will live our lives, and the choices we make, whether to help others or to pursue our individualistic goals, will determine if the change of the future leads to progress.

As we leave here tonight and move closer to a future holding tremendous potential for progress, it is important to remember the past, especially all that we have learned in our four years here at CBA. We will eventually forget some of the academic material learned here, but we should never forget the far more valuable knowledge about life we have gained. Regardless of the path we take in the future, this foundation, along with the teachings of Jesus, will provide all of us with help in making the truly difficult decisions of our lives. In closing, I present you with one final challenge: to do all you can to make the future a better one no matter what the sacrifice may be.


