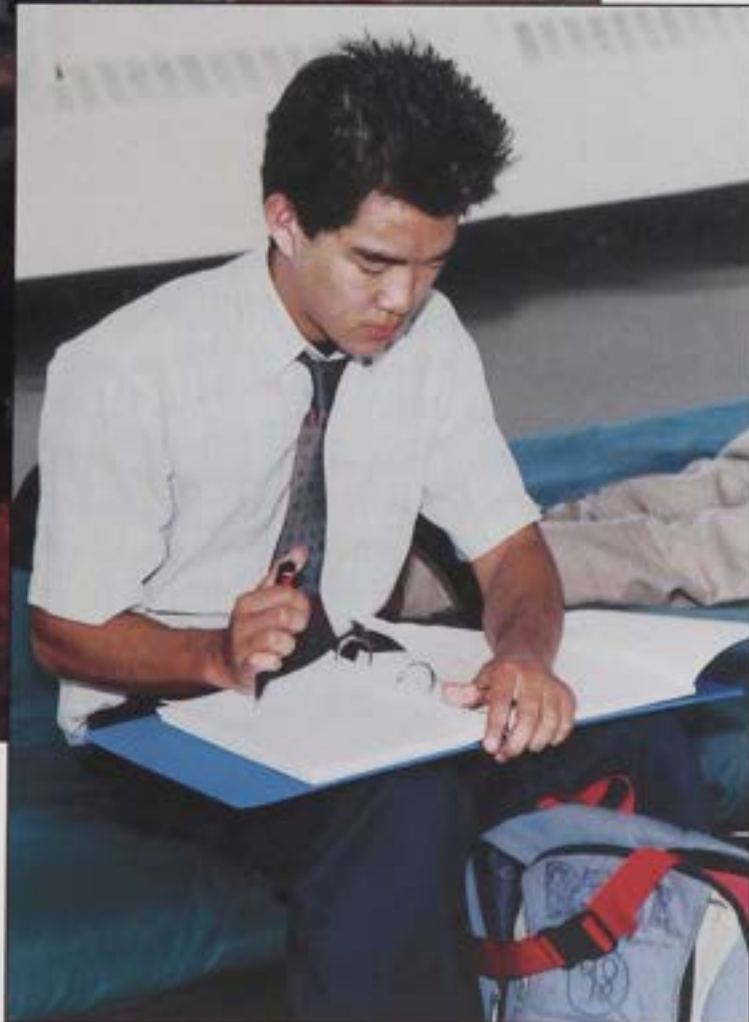
We hope that this book helps you to remember your memories here at C.B.A. long after a life full of change and fulfilled dreams.

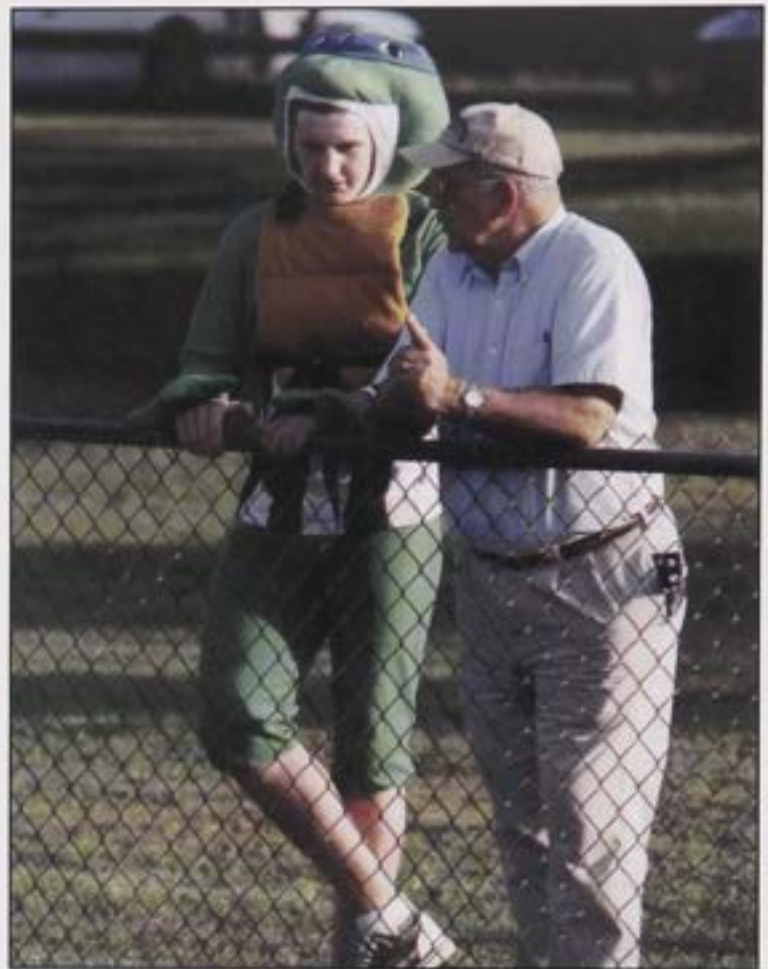


# REMEMBER WHEN . . . .

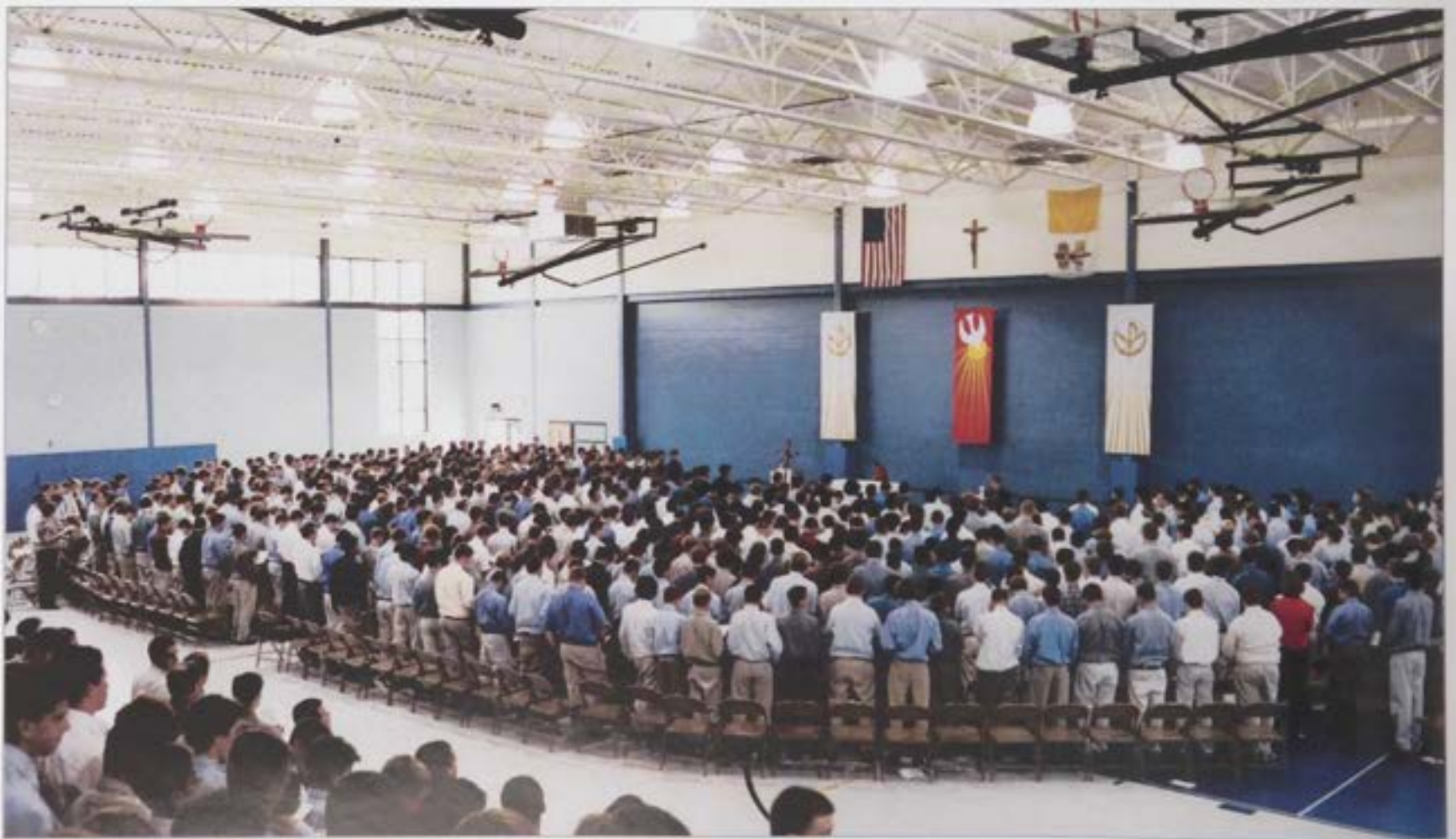

# Campus Ministry

Director: Mr. Timothy Sewnig

Campus Ministry was brought back this year under the supervision of Mr. Timothy Sewnig. The Ministry is a crucial aspect to Christian life at CBA. Mainly, it serves to supplement the efforts of the Religious Studies Department through an application of Christian virtues and liturgical involvement at the Academy.

For students with a common thirst for spiritual involvement, Campus Ministry sponsors the LaSallian Youth Group, which not only contributes to building new and lasting friendships, but also helps the community by raising money and feeding the poor. Twice monthly a group of students distribute food and clothes in a depressed area of the Jersey Shore.

Another role filled by the Campus Ministry is the organization of the many school-wide Liturgies. Every year, students gather as a community during especially important days in the liturgical calendar. Father John Folchetti is the celebrant during these Liturgy days, and Mr. Pat Scott leads the musical part of the Mass. The Campus Ministry Team also takes care of consideration of those students that apply for Liturgical Ministries and wish to help during Mass.

A key requirement for graduation at CBA is to have completed four religious retreats during one's academic career here. Campus Ministry is also in charge of arranging these retreat days and takes particular care in planning activities that are spiritually fulfilling regardless of the religious affiliations of the students. These days are full of deep reflection and prayer and provide for a part of each individual that is crucial to the development of character.

Finally, there are the Ministry-sponsored food drives. This year, the student body broke CBA's previous record in cans, with an overall count of over 20,000 cans during the Thanksgiving Food Drive.

Campus Ministry this year supported by the leadership of Mr. Sewnig will absolutely prove to be one of the most memorable years in Ministry history.





# LaSallian Youth Group

LaSallian Youth seek to live out the ideals of St. John Baptist DeLaSalle: Faith, Service & Community. Members explore their faith as young adult Christians through service to the needy in Asbury Park and subsequent wrap-up reflections in the Campus Ministry Office. Members prepare about 150 bag lunches and distribute the sandwiches, along with used clothing, at the Asbury Park train Station twice a month. Students also volunteer their time as tutors for children at the Missionary Sisters of Charity after school program in Asbury. It is in encountering the brokenness of their neighbor that these young men encounter The Holy Presence of God.

While a total of 50 is mandatory for graduation, the majority of students far exceed this minimum. The service projects are restricted to Christian service and include making sandwiches for the needy, raising money for the poor, serving on various volunteer organizations within their community, and tutoring others. While their works help the less fortunate, they also enrich the students themselves; through this volunteer service, they often foster relationships with the people they serve and develop closer ties with the community.





# GURU

## Give Us Religious Understanding

The peer ministry GURU has a long tradition of helping freshmen adapt to the sometimes intimidating environment of CBA and beyond. Led by Dr. Koch and Mr. Finn, seniors meet once a cycle with a freshmen religion class to conduct group talks and offer advice on high school life. Topics of discussion include the Gospels, peer pressure, world issues, and adolescent life in general.

Outside the freshmen classroom, the seniors discuss their progress with the underclassmen and explore the intricacies of group psychology with Dr. Koch and Mr. Finn. Because of its unmatched combination of mentorship and scholarship, the GURU program has quickly become one of the most sought-after and enriching courses at the Academy.

# A Lesson in Bravery & Forgiveness

Detective Steven McDonald



In November 2003, Detective Steven McDonald, a paralyzed New York City police officer, addressed the school on issues varying from teen violence to forgiveness in the face of death. Detective McDonald related his story of tragedy and recovery. Twenty years ago, Det. McDonald was shot repeatedly by teenagers while he was patrolling Central Park. This attack left Det. McDonald paralyzed from the neck down. Rather than succumbing to feelings of anger and vengeance, Det. McDonald chose to follow the path of forgiveness and pardon his assailants. Det. McDonald has traveled around the country teaching forgiveness through his heart rending yet ultimately inspiring story. We thank the detective and can only hope to become as forgiving and compassionate.

## Dorothy Day

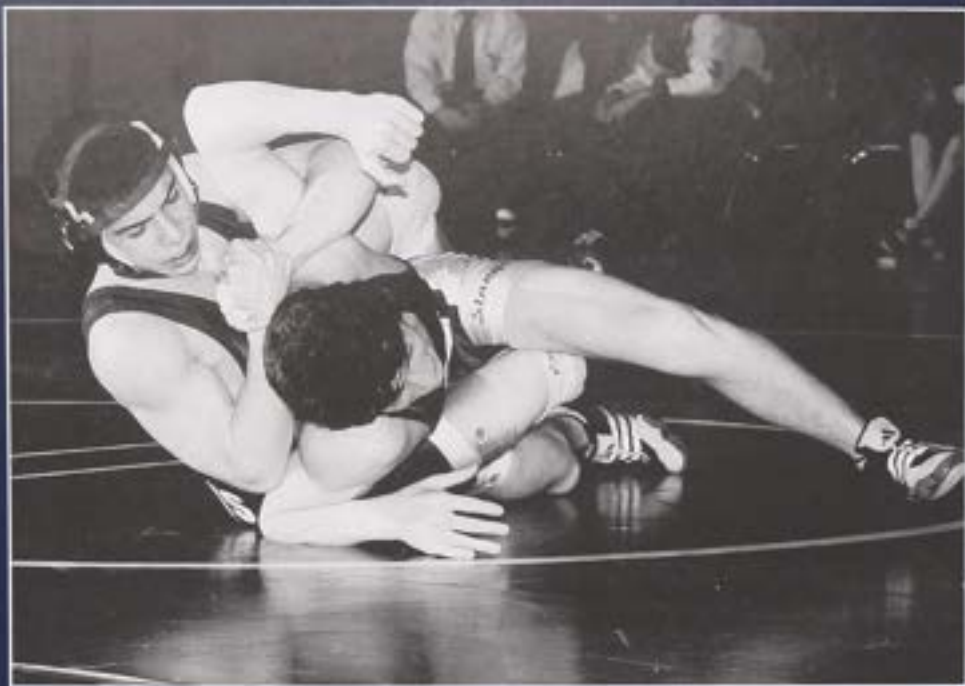

# history department

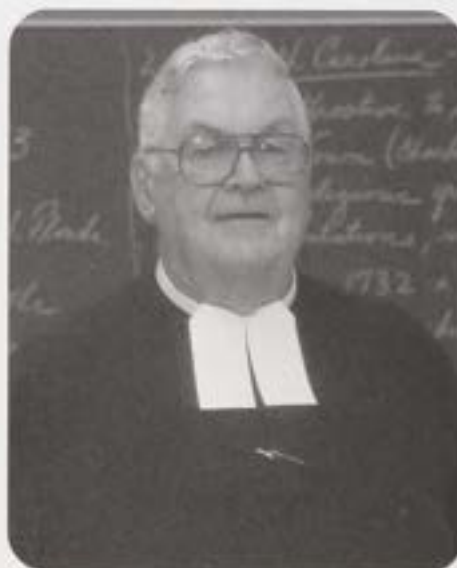

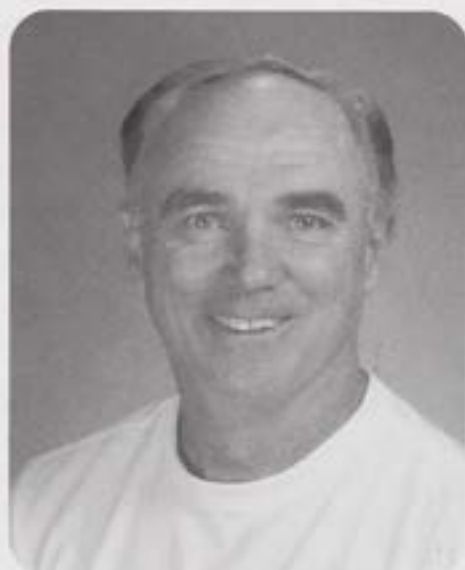

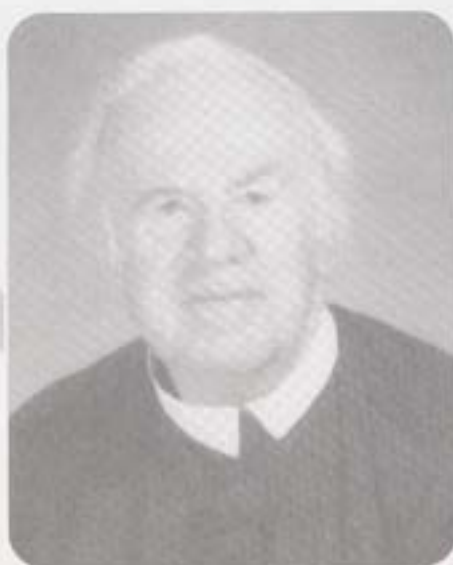


# Computer Department

Students are held to national standards during the Fitness Test taken every year by each class. A minimum score in the test - which is comprised of pushups, sit-ups, pull-ups, a mile run, and a shuttle run is required to pass for the year. Classes are held outside, weather permitting, and include an eclectic curriculum covering many different sports.

# *Information Services Department*

The Library is the primary research tool for CBA students. With an impressive collection of intellectual texts, the Library is a premiere resource for anyone with a paper to write or a project to finish. The Information Services Department can also boast an always-growing collection of encyclopedic sources, including the Encyclopedia Britannica and Americana. Open before and after school, the Library is almost always available to students, whether they need to do some research or just finish up some work.

# *Andrew's year at the Academy...*

---

## **Brother Andrew O'Gara**

This marks the 25<sup>th</sup> year of Brother Andrew's leadership at Christian Brothers Academy, 12 as principal and the past 13 as president. During this time, CBA has undergone dramatic growth due in large part to Brother's vision, faith and determination.

When he arrived in 1979 little had been done in developing the physical plant or in preparing for the long term future of CBA. In the Spring of 1983, Brother announced the plans for *Project 80's* and spent much time and energy raising the \$2.5m that it took to bring the construction to fruition. Having successfully completed the Project, Brother, in conjunction with the Board of Trustees, determined that fund-raising and promoting the Academy was a necessary and full time job. To that end, he was appointed CBA's first President in 1991.

Brother Andrew quickly made the role of President his own and did so in his usual colorful manner. Then, with the Academy continuing to grow and offer more and more specialized programs, the need for further expansion became apparent. At a time when most other men his age were retiring, Brother Andrew spearheaded yet another extensive financial campaign and oversaw the construction of such proportions that it doubled the size of the existing building. *Project 2000* was a raving success and was completed in 1997, earlier than anticipated. With the over \$6m project finished and paid for, Brother turned his efforts to building the endowment fund to secure the financial future of CBA for generations to come.

With a remarkable ability to remember everyone's name and to know something about them, Brother Andrew O'Gara exudes a deep sense of compassion and warmth to his students and colleagues. He is richly embedded in the tradition of St. John Baptist de La Salle and brought the first awareness of the developing definitions of La Sallian characteristics to the CBA community. His ease with people and self-effacing sense of humor have made him a very popular figure within the extended CBA family. For many alumni and parents, Brother Andrew is among the first thoughts they have of when they think of CBA. To list all of his accomplishments on behalf of Christian Brothers Academy over these 25 years would be nigh to impossible, but suffice to say, that in every circumstance, he does what he does with the welfare of the entire CBA community first and foremost in his mind.

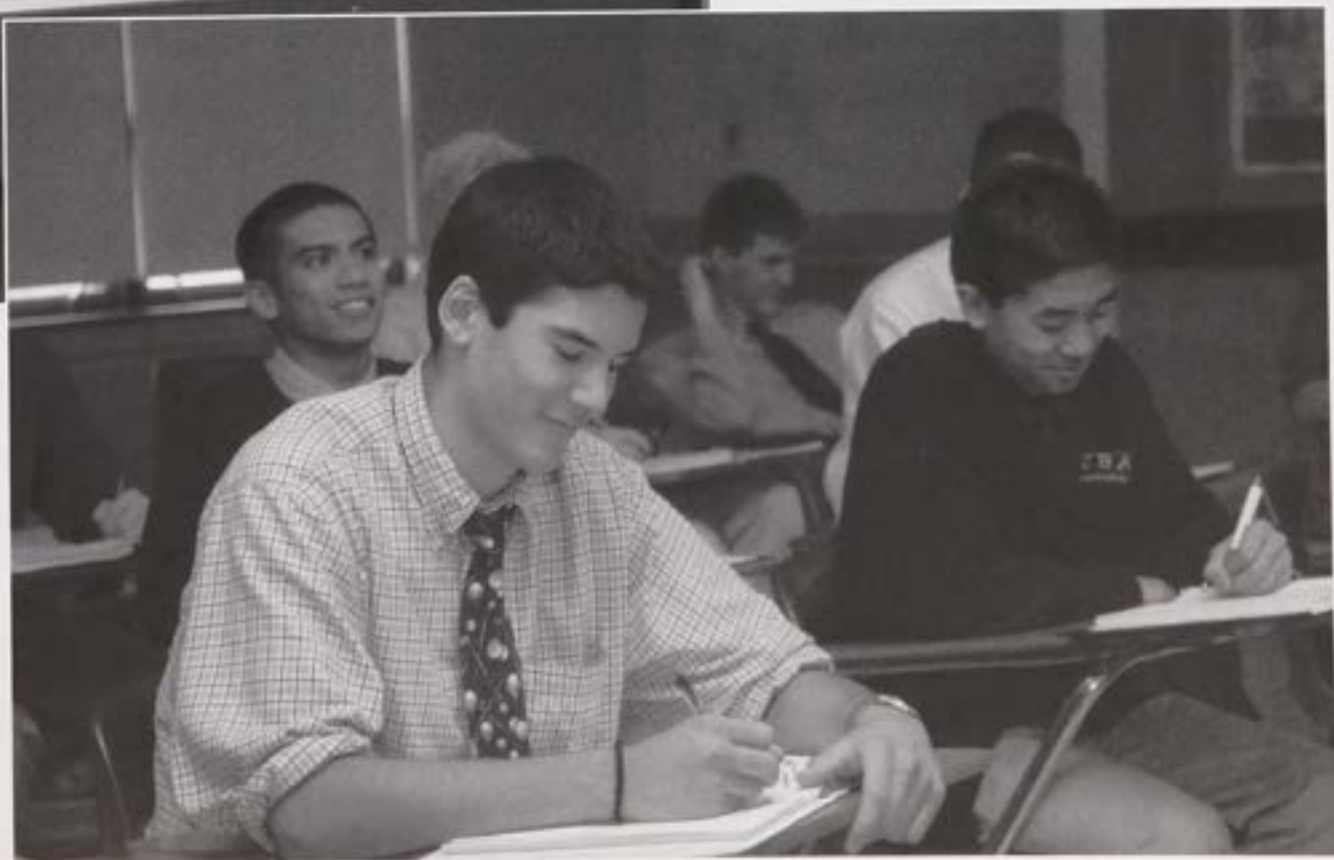

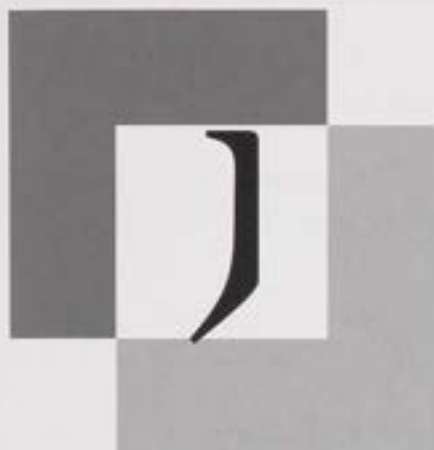




# Editor's Page

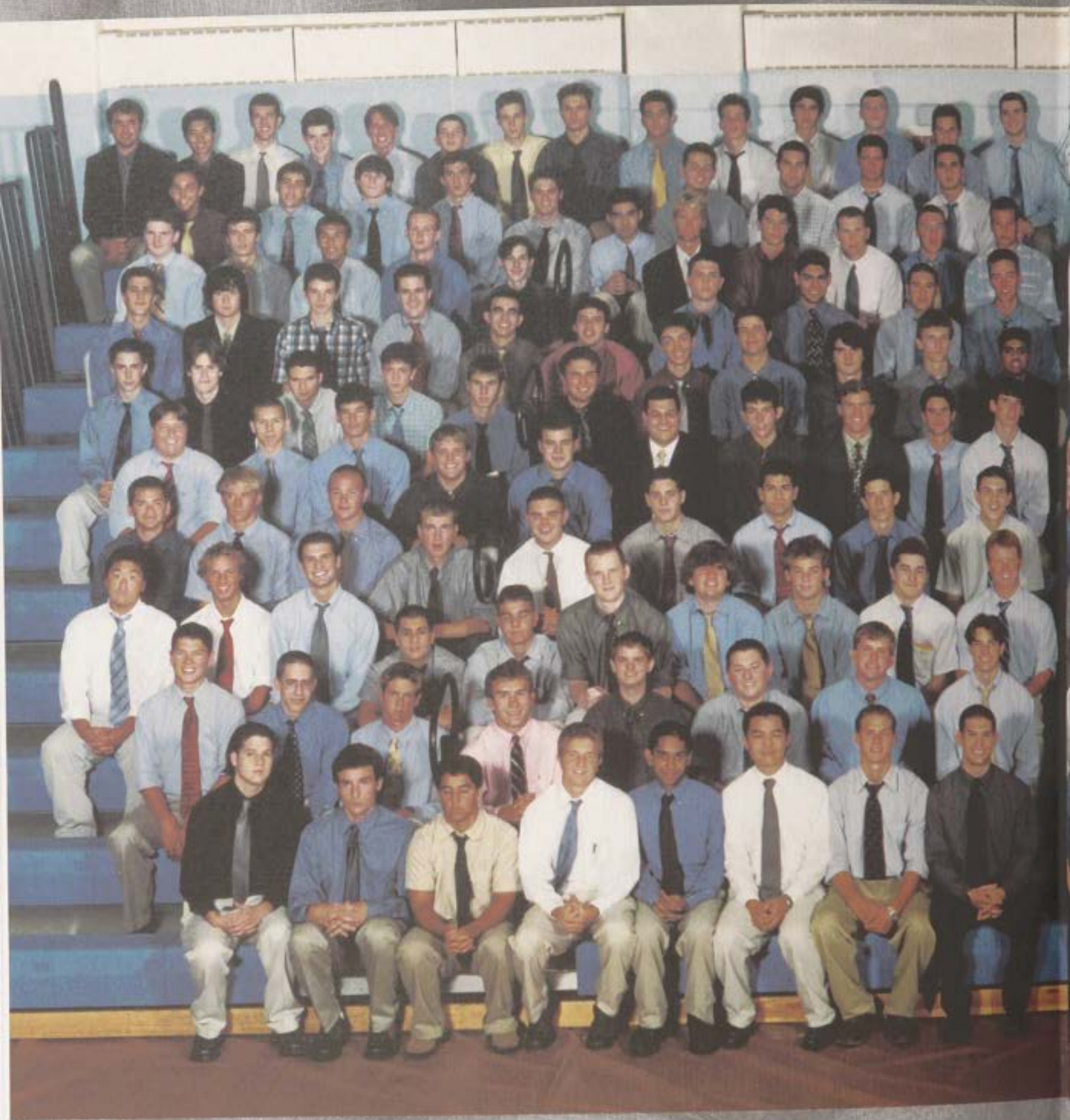

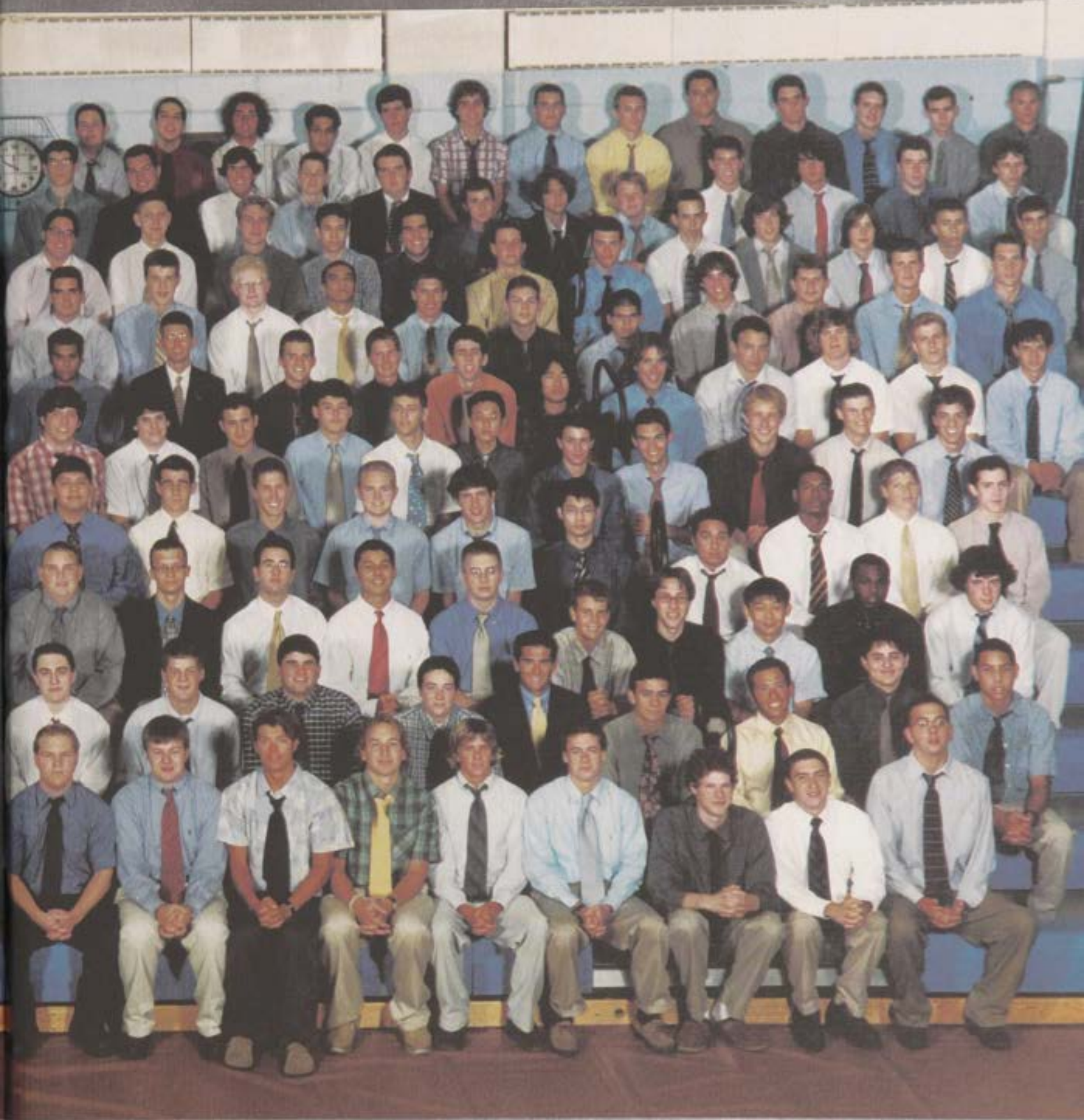
