# Beyond the Boundaries

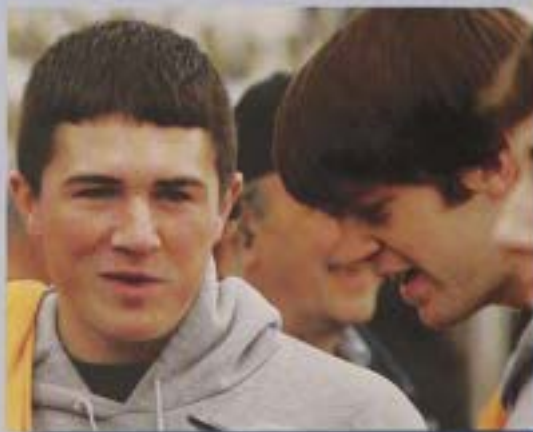
Anyone who has had the opportunity to become acquainted with Christian Brothers Academy has realized that there is something intrinsically different about its environment compared to other places. Considering the sizable portion of the faculty who are alumni, the many generations of fathers who have sent their sons to the same school they attended, and the appreciation for CBA that so many graduates exude even years after they are no longer students, it seems evident that these differences are positive. Despite the occasional grumbling of students about the apparently unending supply of work, the rush to complete service hours and forms, and the intensity of the sports programs, in the end, for one reason or another, these same students are proud to call themselves men of the Academy and would not have had their experiences otherwise.

Indeed, though at times daunting, these challenges are the pillars of the meaningfulness of Christian Brothers Academy's education. Anyone who has attended CBA is familiar with the work *Beyond the Boundaries* and with the ideas of Saint LaSalle, constitute the school's education philosophy. Graduation from CBA does not merely suggest but requires its students to extend themselves beyond the bare minimum amount of effort. The rigorous academics of CBA teach its students to grasp the world with their minds and thereby enable them to change it. The service program (be it service hours, the food drive, or the Lenten collection) has taught students the importance of compassion and the ability to care about the world in which they live. The rigor and perennial success of the sports program has taught athletes the true meaning of effort and reward, while establishing a genuine sense of camaraderie among fans.

These three elements combine to enrich everyone who has gone through Christian Brothers Academy and make the school an especially meaningful place. Yet, though CBA may seem different from other places because of these things, it does not isolate itself. The personal characteristics that it instills are not restricted to a landed property or time. Rather, Christian Brothers Academy urges all of us to spread these messages without boundary, whether that means outside of school or after graduation. Each of us is called to go beyond the boundaries of ourselves or a given time and place and to pursue God through such forms as academics, service and athletics. Perhaps the Academy's greatest message is to live your life as such an example for others.

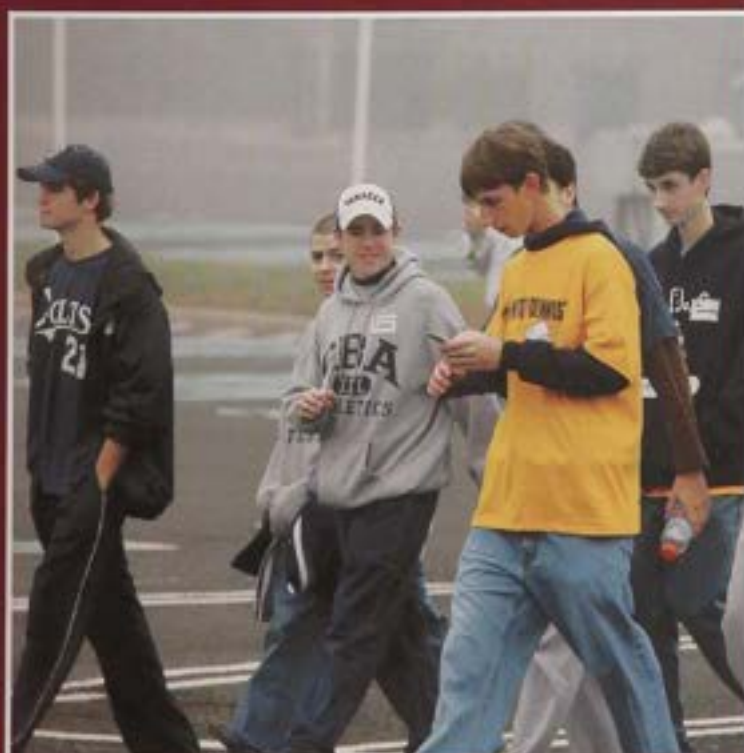
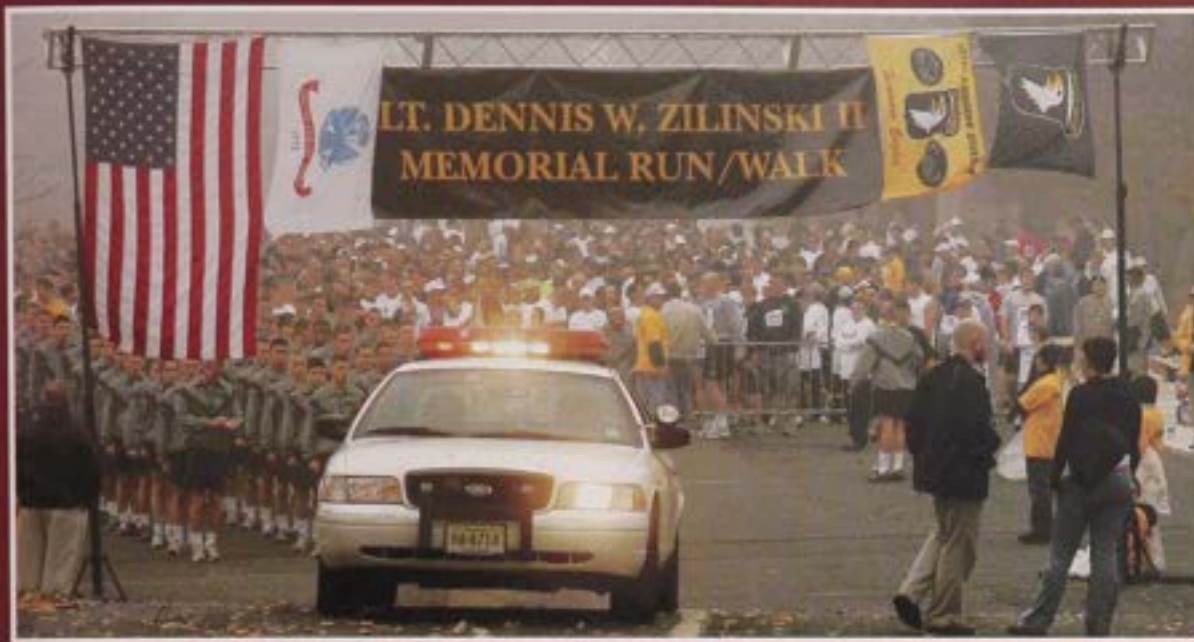
## National Honor Society
