15 Things you may not know about your Principal

 After his graduation from Rutgers University, Mr. Ross Fales began his teaching career at Mount Saint Mary Academy, a private high school for girls, teaching biology and chemistry.

- A varsity swimmer at Rutgers, Mr. Fales began his coaching career as head swim coach at the Metuchen Edison YMCA. He later served as assistant swim coach at CBA from 2002-2007.

- He coached JV basketball and Varsity Soccer at Mount Saint Mary Academy.

 An avid snowboarder, he co-moderated the Mount Saint Mary Ski Club even driving the school bus for club day trips.

- During his time at Mount Saint Mary Academy he worked on set design and construction with the theater program but refused invitations to pursue an acting career.

 He spent three years as a science teacher at Long Branch High School before coming to CBA.

- He earned a Master's degree from Seton Hall University while teaching at CBA.

- In 2006 Brother Andrew O'Gara appointed him Dean of Students and in 2007 he was appointed Associate Principal for Student Affairs.

- As Associate Principal he worked tirelessly to improve the student experience at CBA.

- He oversaw the start of several sports on the club level including rugby, sailing and fencing; all of which went on to become varsity programs.

- Mr. Fales expanded the music program, adding jazz band as a period zero class and encouraged both jazz band and men's choir to participate in music competitions.

 His support for the music program would surprise his childhood piano teacher because despite her expertise she could just not get him to master the piano.

- Many new clubs were added during his tenure as associate principal including comic book and anime, Brazilian Jiu Jitsu and Teens for Oceans to name just a few.

- Mr. Fales loves the ocean and has spent many summers as a beach life guard—even meeting his future wife on the beach and years later living just blocks away from the ocean with his wife and three children. In his little free time he still likes to break out the surf board.

- As principal, Mr. Fales hopes to uphold the great legacy and traditions of the Academy, while also guiding CBA in the progress necessary to continue delivering an excellent, holistic and Christian education in the 21st century.


Mrs. Therese Heidelberger

Dennis Zilinski was killed as a result of a roadside bombing near Bayji, Iraq. In an act of love, the Lt. Dennis W. Zilinski, II Memorial Fund, a 501(c)(3) non profit organization, has been established by his friends and family to provide various forms of assistance to wounded service members, and to support academic scholarships at CBA.






















LaSallian Youth Mission Trip To The Blackfeet Reservation in Montana

In October 2015 several CBA students, led by Mr. Butler and Mr. Sewnig, traveled to the Blackfeet Nation in Browning, Montana to partake in a service and cultural immersion trip. Located just south of the Canada - United States border, the reservation suffers from a wide range of socio-economic problems including widespread poverty, alcoholism, abuse, and drug use. The group representing CBA spent the week tutoring students within the De La Salle Blackfeet School, a grammar school run by the Christian Brothers for students in grades 4-8. The group helped to reinforce the mission of the Brothers and the school: to help direct youth on the reservation towards a positive path moving forward into high school and beyond. The group was privileged to encounter the Blackfeet culture firsthand through several different immersion experiences made possible during the stay. Overall, the experience proved to be immensely profound spiritually for those involved while it also reinforced the service-oriented, LaSallian spirit of CBA.










































































LaSallian Youth








SADD






Action for Animals



























French Club














Irish Club






FBLA


Sci-Fi and Fantasy Club
