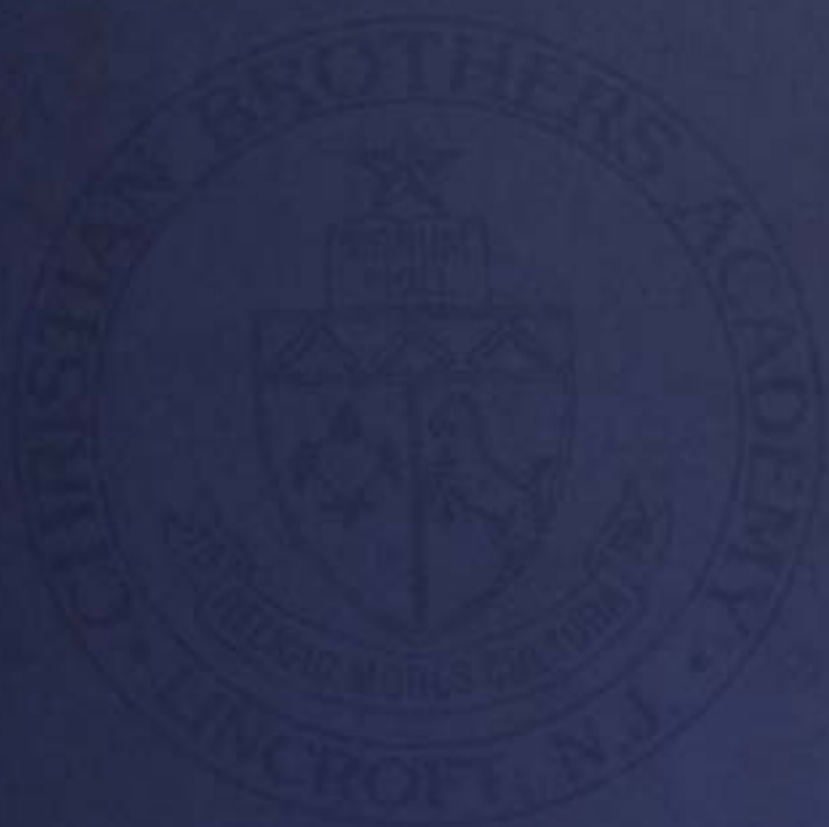

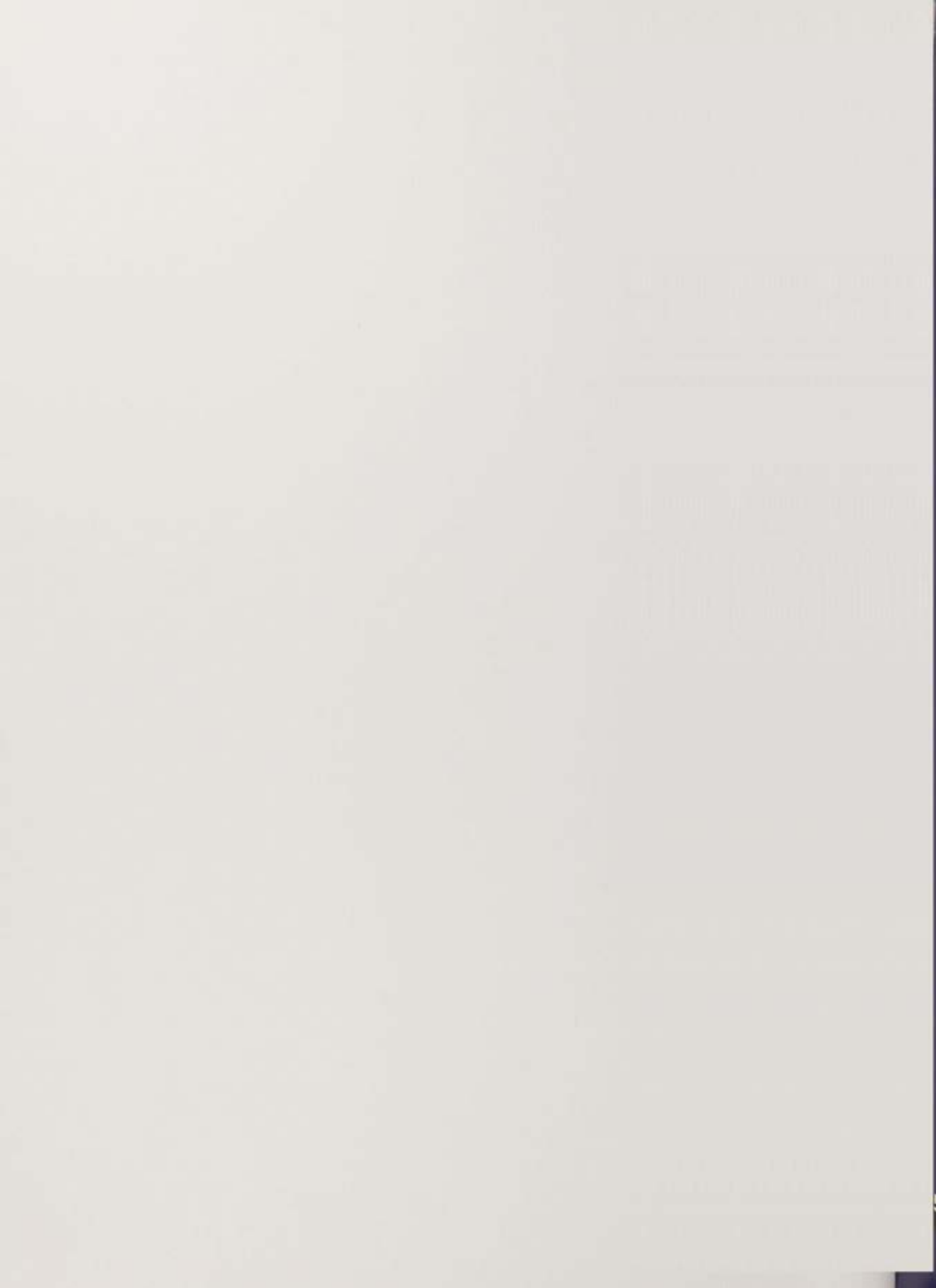

15 Things you may not know about your Principal

- After his graduation from Rutgers University, Mr. Ross Fales began his teaching career at Mount Saint Mary Academy, a private high school for girls, teaching biology and chemistry.
- A varsity swimmer at Rutgers, Mr. Fales began his coaching career as head swim coach at the Metuchen Edison YMCA. He later served as assistant swim coach at CBA from 2002-2007.
- He coached JV basketball and Varsity Soccer at Mount Saint Mary Academy.
- An avid snowboarder, he co-moderated the Mount Saint Mary Ski Club even driving the school bus for club day trips.
- During his time at Mount Saint Mary Academy he worked on set design and construction with the theater program but refused invitations to pursue an acting career.
- He spent three years as a science teacher at Long Branch High School before coming to CBA.
- He earned a Master's degree from Seton Hall University while teaching at CBA.
- In 2006 Brother Andrew O'Gara appointed him Dean of Students and in 2007 he was appointed Associate Principal for Student Affairs.
- As Associate Principal he worked tirelessly to improve the student experience at CBA.
- He oversaw the start of several sports on the club level including rugby, sailing and fencing; all of which went on to become varsity programs.
- Mr. Fales expanded the music program, adding jazz band as a period zero class and encouraged both jazz band and men's choir to participate in music competitions.
- His support for the music program would surprise his childhood piano teacher because despite her expertise she could just not get him to master the piano.
- Many new clubs were added during his tenure as associate principal including comic book and anime, Brazilian Jiu Jitsu and Teens for Oceans to name just a few.
- Mr. Fales loves the ocean and has spent many summers as a beach life guard—even meeting his future wife on the beach and years later living just blocks away from the ocean with his wife and three children. In his little free time he still likes to break out the surf board.
- As principal, Mr. Fales hopes to uphold the great legacy and traditions of the Academy, while also guiding CBA in the progress necessary to continue delivering an excellent, holistic and Christian education in the 21st century.

Men of the Class of 2016:



He then returned as a Guidance Counselor at CBA from 1999-2004. Prior to returning back to CBA for the 2015-2016 school year, Mr. Finn worked for Halliburton. In 1980, he was named Varsity Tennis Coach. Additionally, Mr. Keane was the Department Chair for History from 1977 to 1987. Mr. Keane has gained a captivating reputation over the years, earning him the nickname as simply "Coach" from his students and the faculty he works with. Thank you Mr. Keane for the 39 wonderful years of teaching and excellence on both the soccer field and the tennis courts!



Mr. Tom Heath '65 returned to his alma mater to coach a sport he himself did not participate in. Years later, he would cement a legacy as one of the greatest high school coaches of any sport in United States history; leading young men, year after year, to defend a young Academy's running tradition. His accomplishments as a coach would include a streak of 343 consecutive wins, a horse barn full of hardware, 21 NJ All-Group titles, and a lengthy list of athletes that went on to compete at the Division 1 level. Yet Heath's greatest accomplishment lies in the mentality he stressed to his athletes, his students, and the Christian Brothers Academy community: to strive for victory in all things. His leadership through action helped create Academy traditions like the Freshmen Run as well as CBA Athletics' commitment to above-and-beyond-caliber coaching.

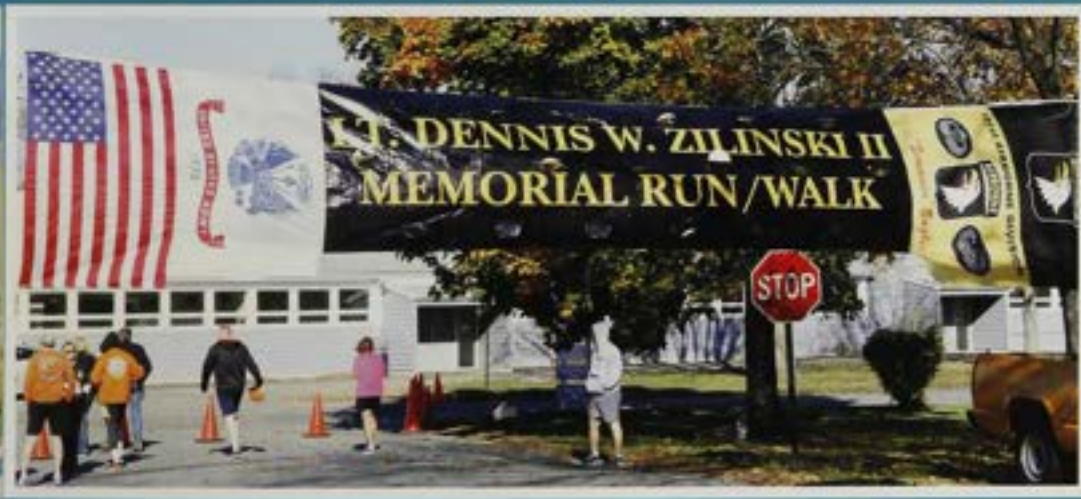




Dennis Zilinski Run

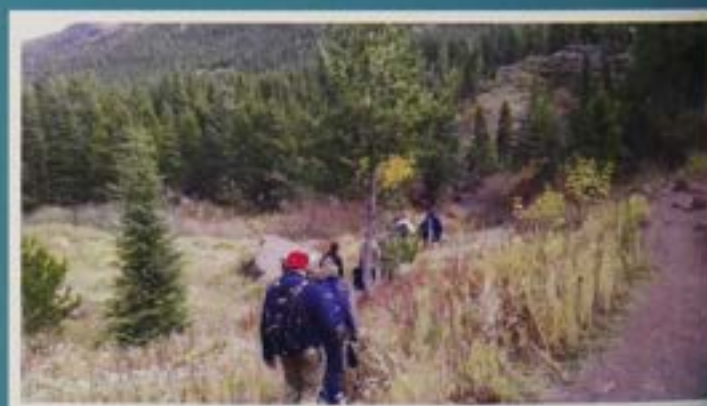

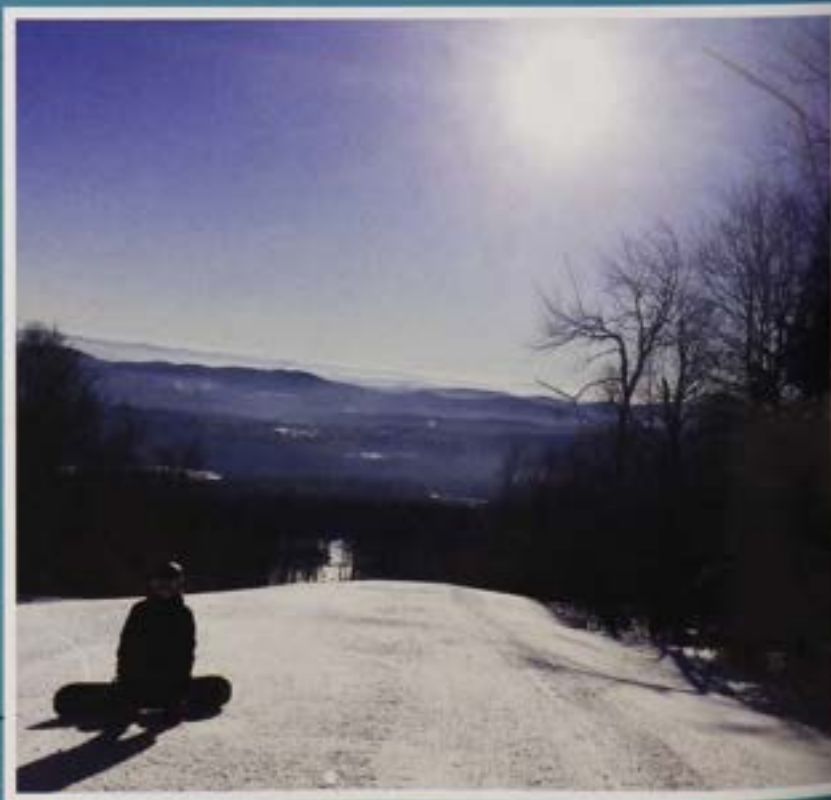
To The Blackfeet Reservation in Montana

In October 2015 several CBA students, led by Mr. Butler and Mr. Sewnig, traveled to the Blackfeet Nation in Browning, Montana to partake in a service and cultural immersion trip. Located just south of the Canada - United States border, the reservation suffers from a wide range of socio-economic problems including widespread poverty, alcoholism, abuse, and drug use. The group representing CBA spent the week tutoring students within the De La Salle Blackfeet School, a grammar school run by the Christian Brothers for students in grades 4-8. The group helped to reinforce the mission of the Brothers and the school: to help direct youth on the reservation towards a positive path moving forward into high school and beyond. The group was privileged to encounter the Blackfeet culture firsthand through several different immersion experiences made possible during the stay. Overall, the experience proved to be immensely profound spiritually for those involved while it also reinforced the service-oriented, LaSallian spirit of CBA.

Once at the conference, student delegates are judged on their position papers and their ability to solve problems through discussion, debate, and negotiation. LaSallian Youth

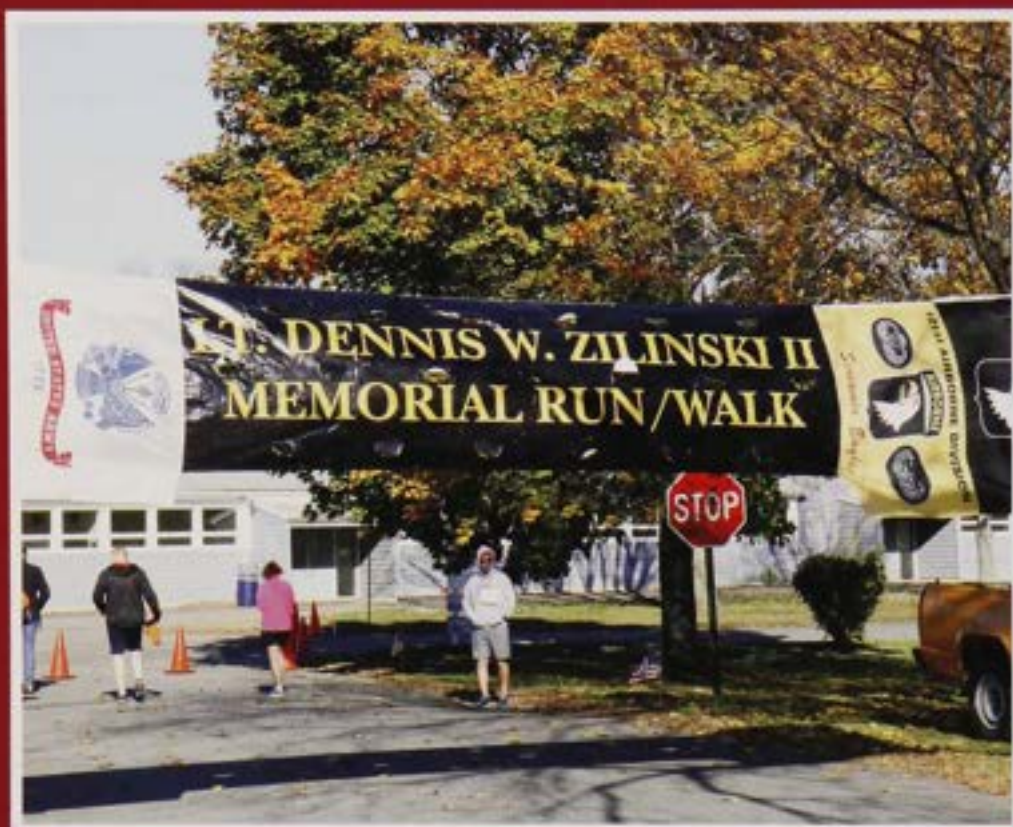

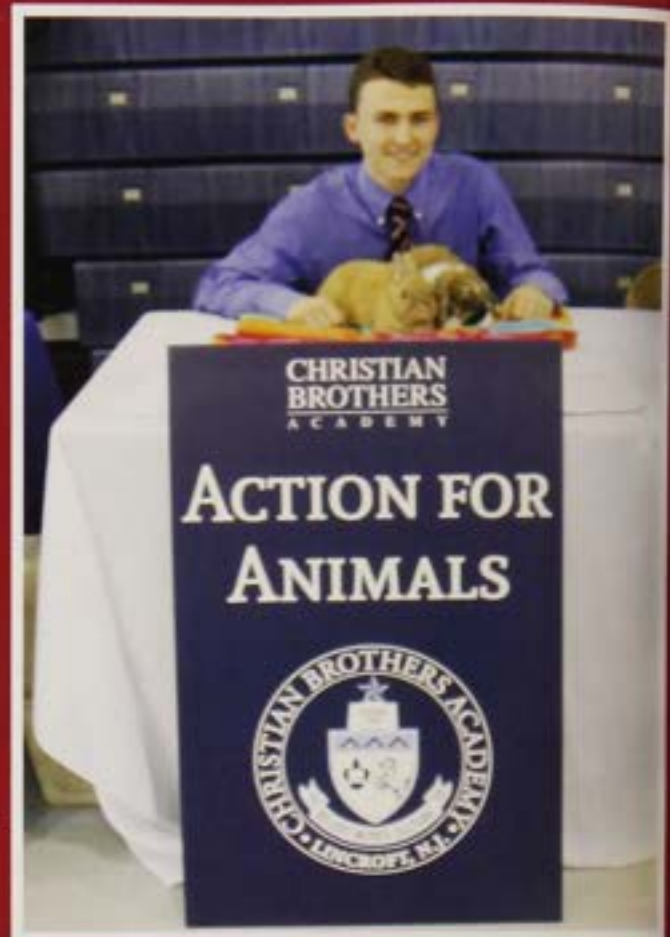

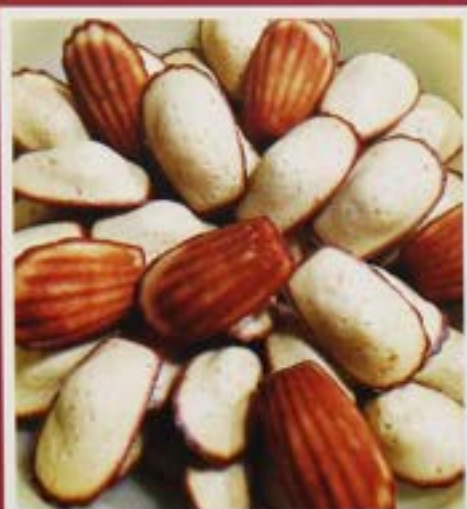

Spanish Club

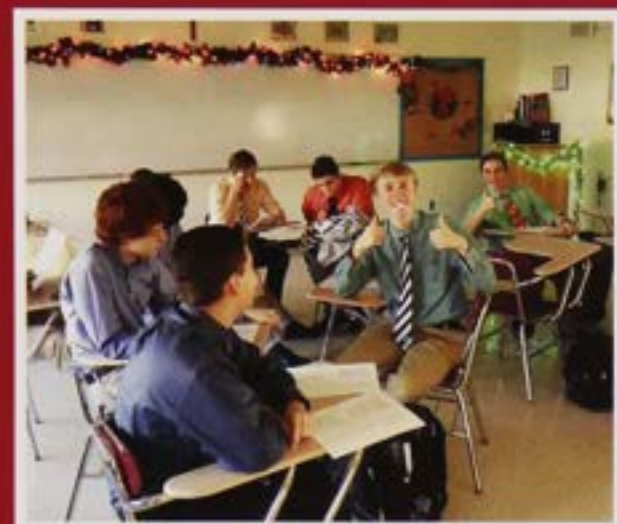

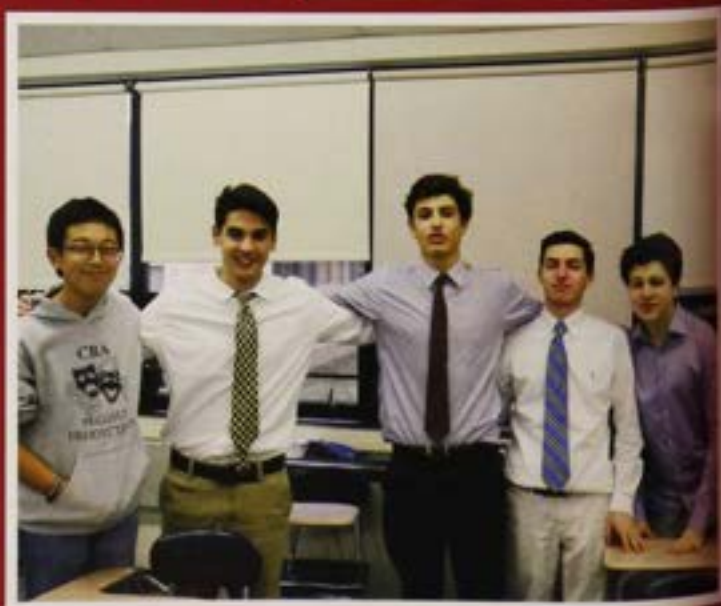
Irish Club

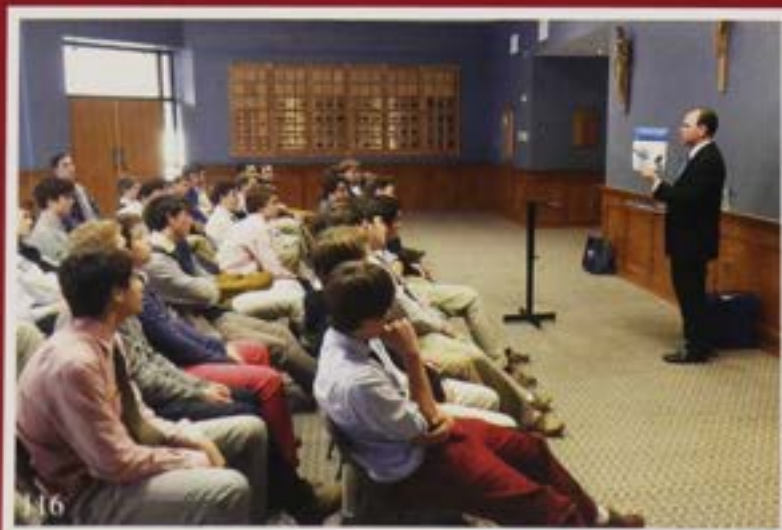
Academy Torch

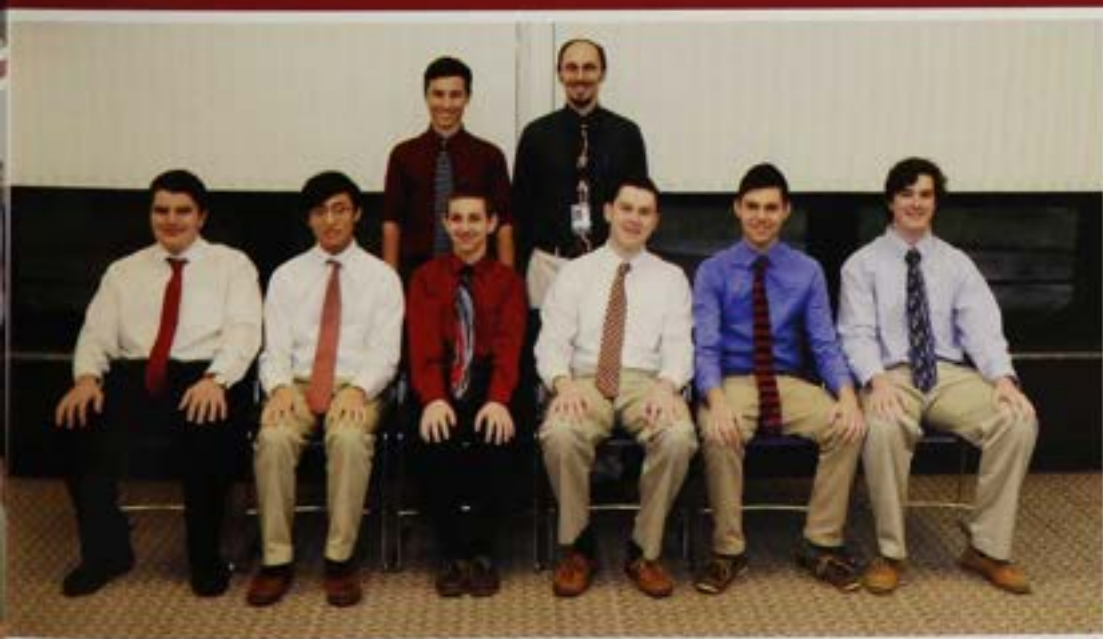
Junior Statesman of America

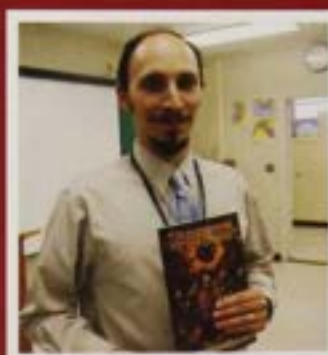
Sci-Fi and Fantasy Club

A Word from the Moderator...

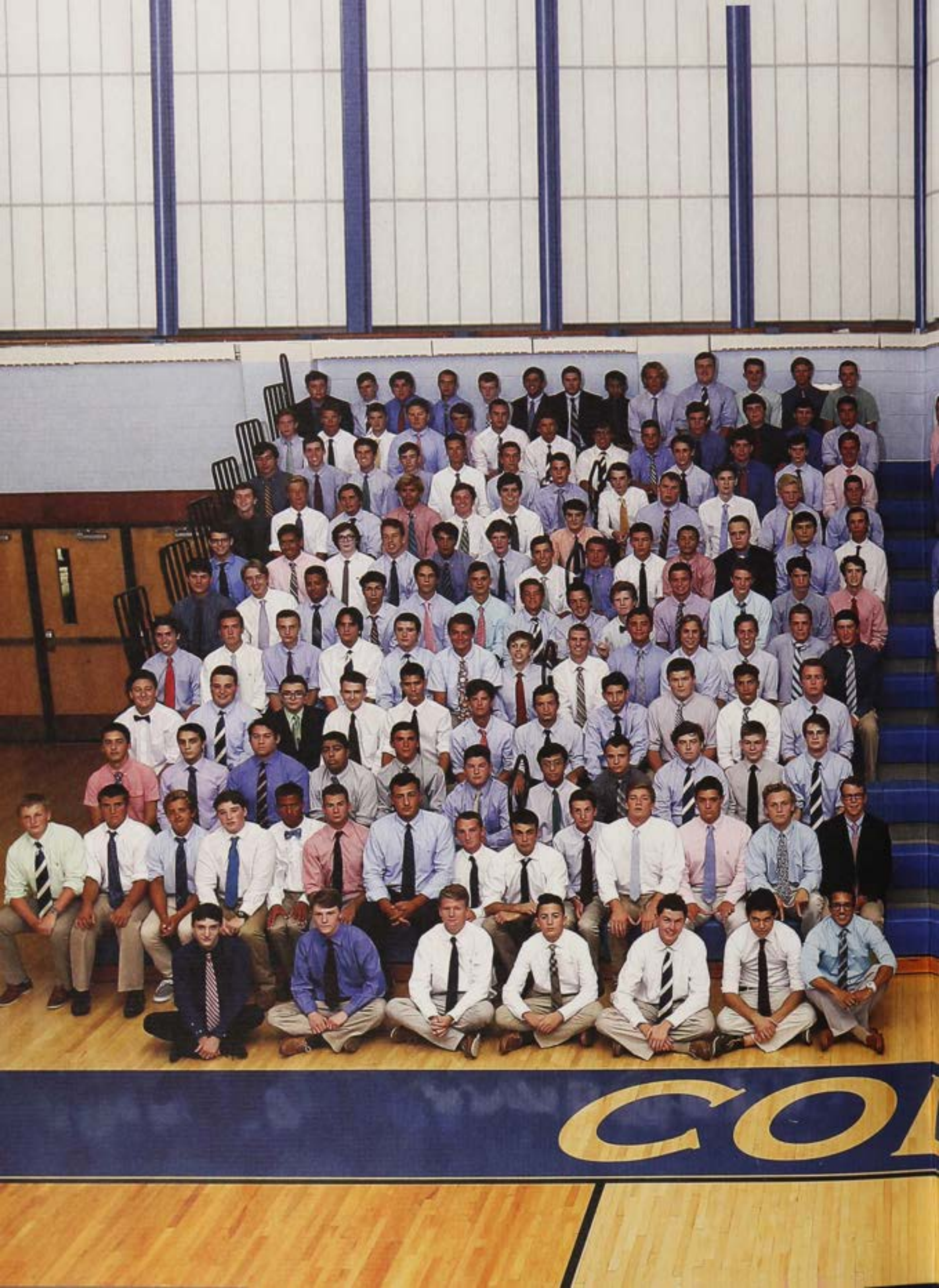
