
# Senions









### The Prom


On February 28, the CBA community gathered to honor students receiving National Merit Awards and academic honors. The program included the induction of thirty eight CBA students into the National Honor Society.

The Brothers aim to direct youth on the reservation towards a positive path moving towards high school and beyond.








#### SADD Talent Show






#### Synopsis






#### Decorum!


# Lasallian Youth

### French Club
















## Freshman


