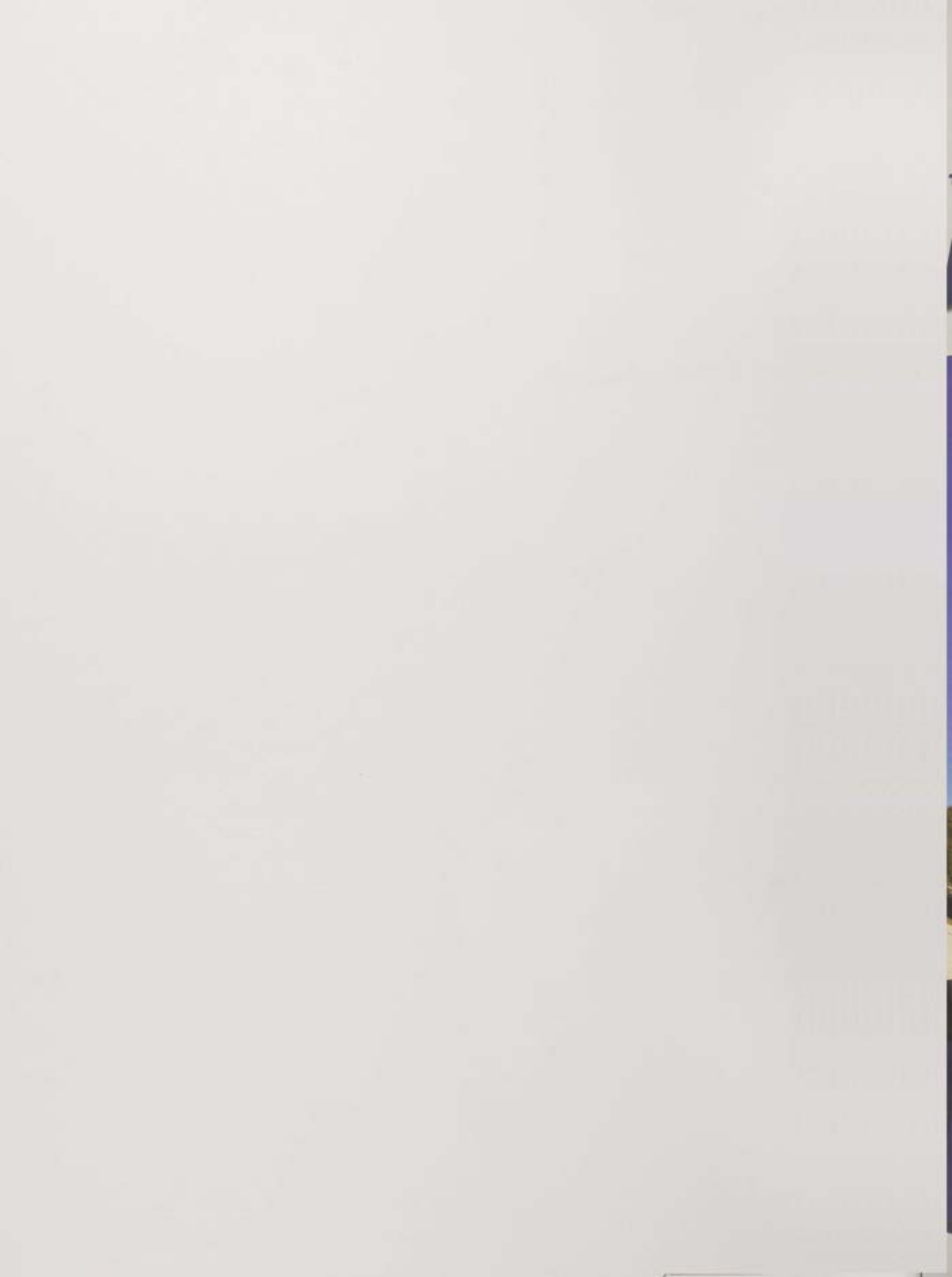

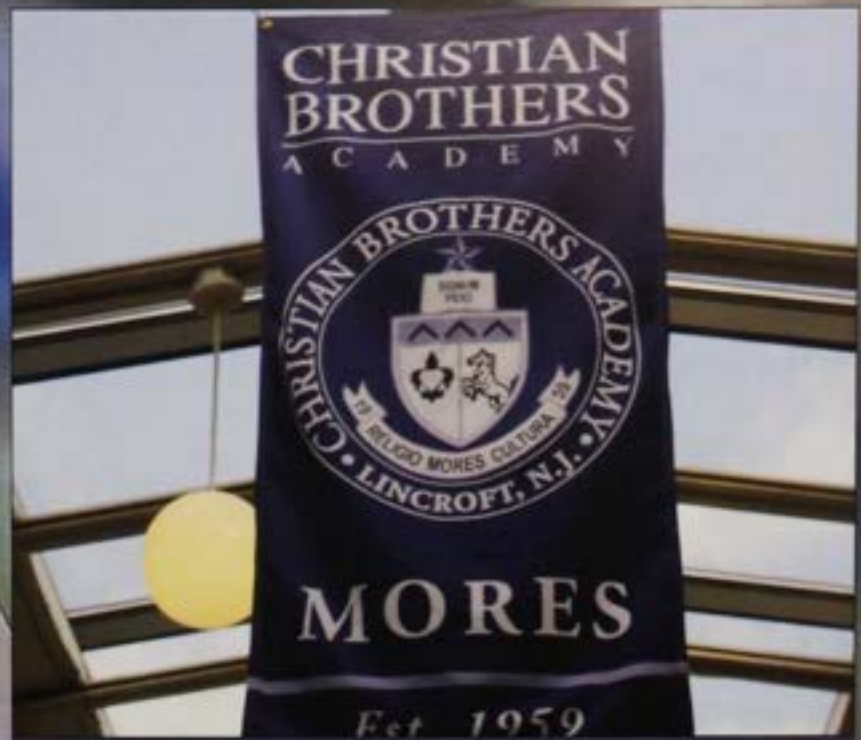
## CBA. Our Seal. Our Story.

Crowning the CBA school seal is the Star of Faith, Signum Fidei, a representation of spirit of faith, or the complete acceptance of God's Will. It is key to the virtue of the Christian Brothers and the students of CBA. The book represents the work of the school - education. The three broken chevrons across the top of the shield are taken from the coat of arms of St. John Baptist de La Salle, the Founder of the Brothers of the Christian Schools and the Patron Saint of teachers. In the left panel is a heart surrounded by a fleur-de-lis, these represent the courage and generosity of the three laymen founders of the academy: Mr. John C. Henderson, Mr. Peter E. Fleming, and Dr. George A. Sheehan Jr. In the right panel is a horse to represent the school's location, which was formerly the Whitney Greentree Sables and Jay Cee Farm. Underscoring the whole seal is a banner bearing the school motto and foundation date.



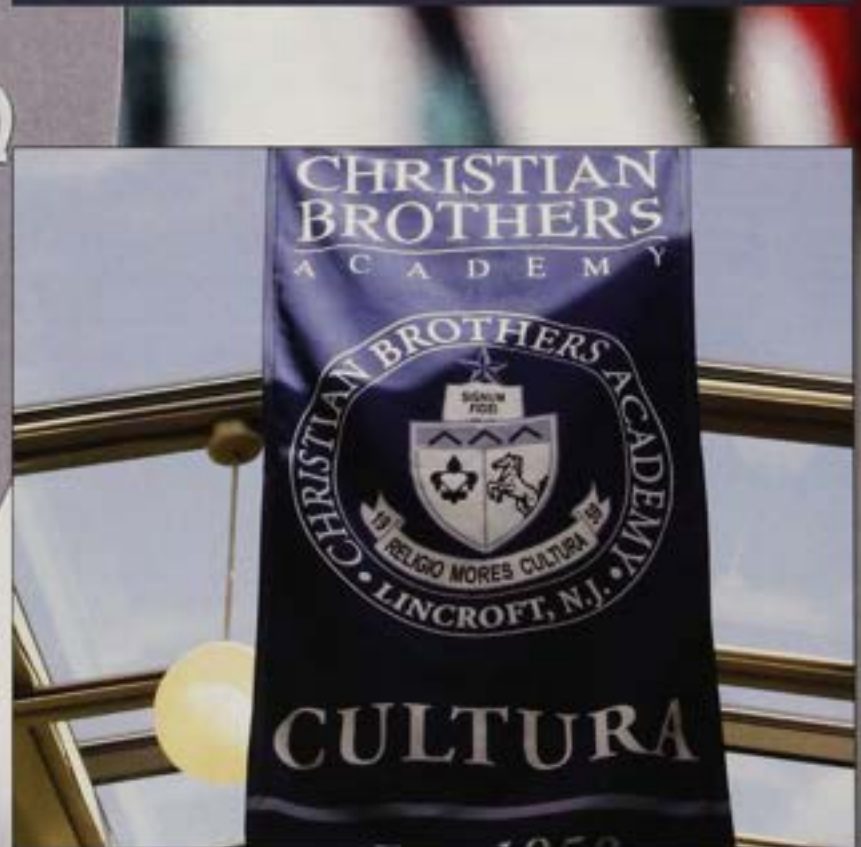
*Religio* is the Latin root word of "religion." In its original form, the term suggested consideration of and connection to the Divine. It suggests a personal relationship with God formed by conscience and integrity. The development of men of Faith is the primary goal of an education at the Academy.

*Mores* is Latin for "manner" or "custom." Originally used to define a set of values, it became the root word for morality. Academy men are morally upstanding men of character who are committed to the service of his brothers, school, and the community at large.

It serves as a reminder of the Academy's goal of fostering the growth of the spirit, mind, and body of each student. # Student Life

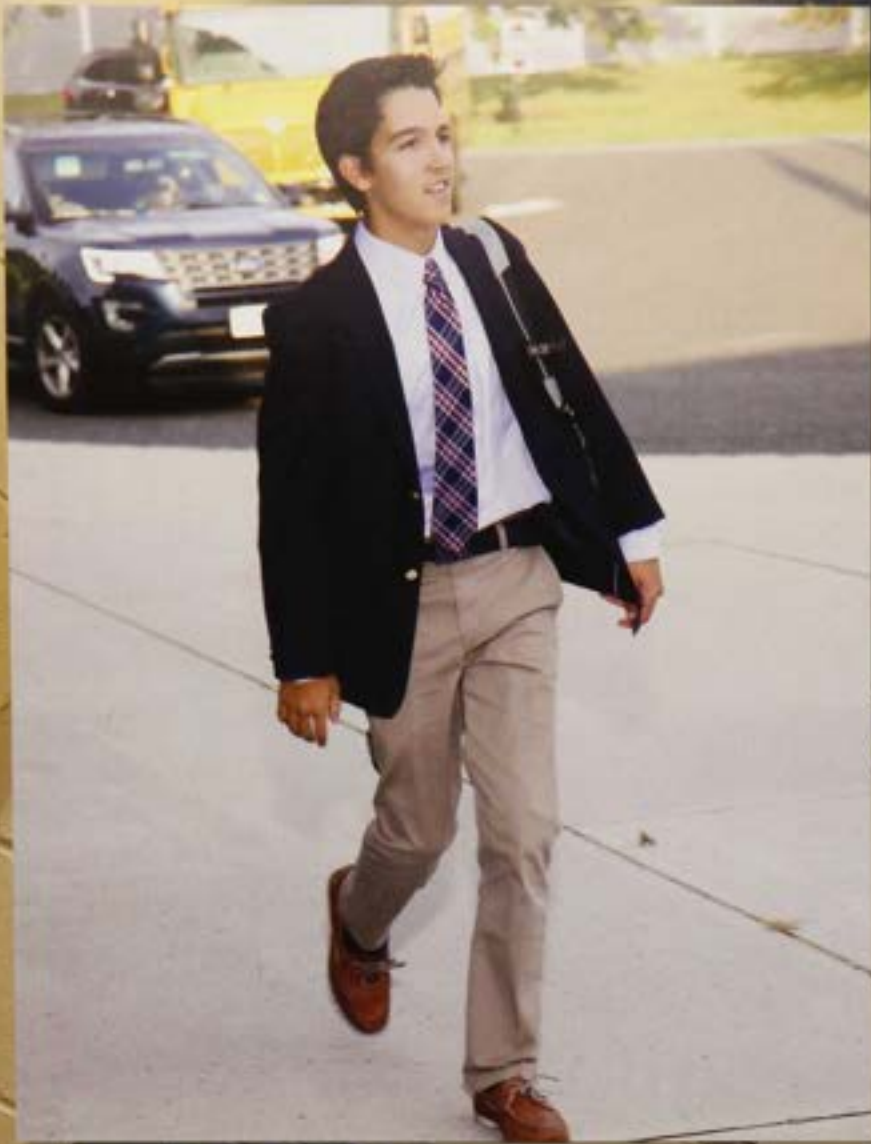

# Music at the Academy

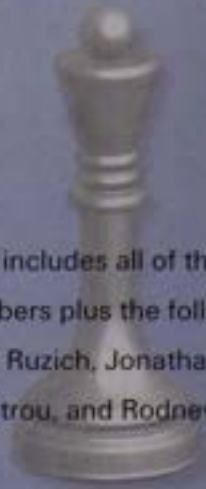

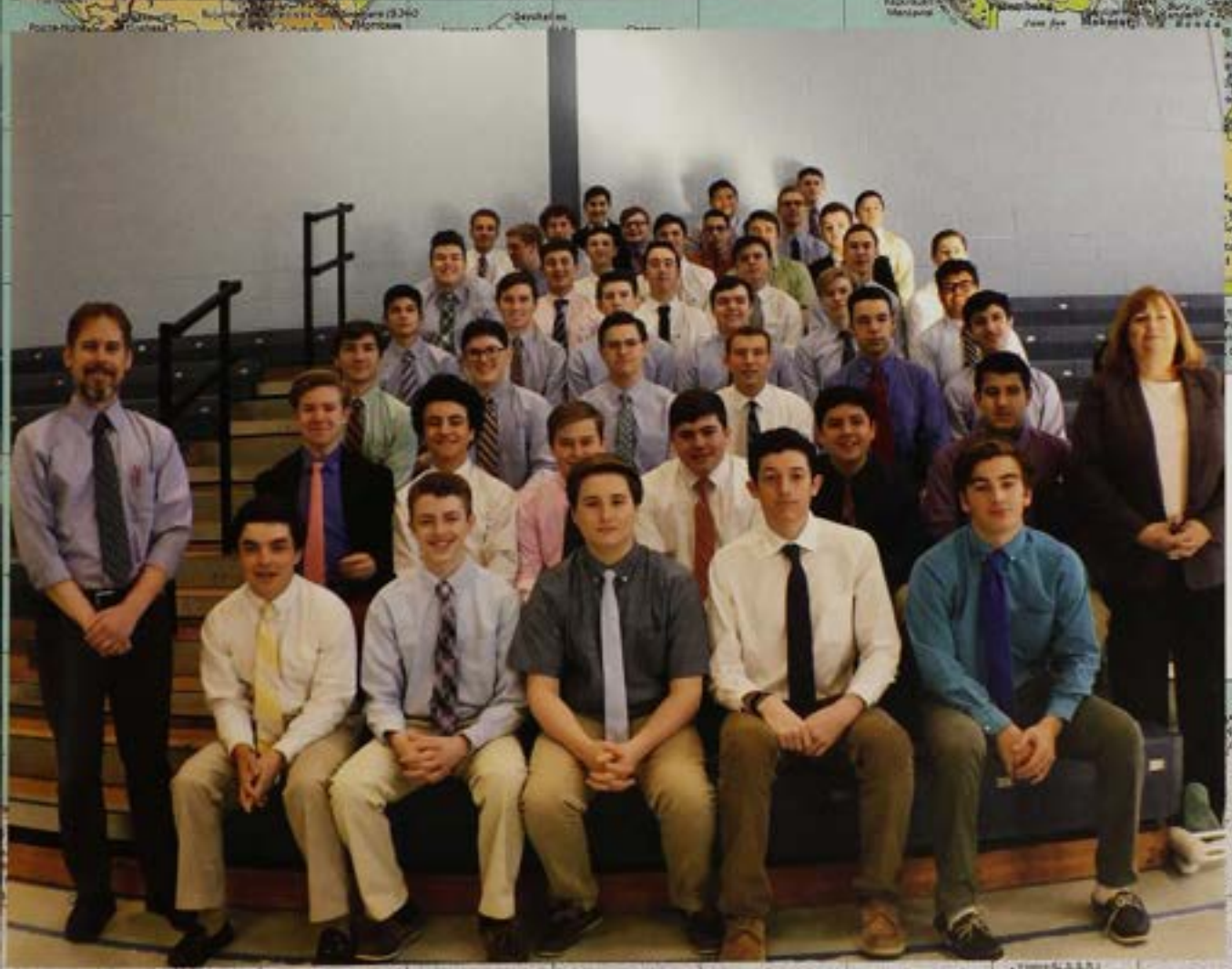


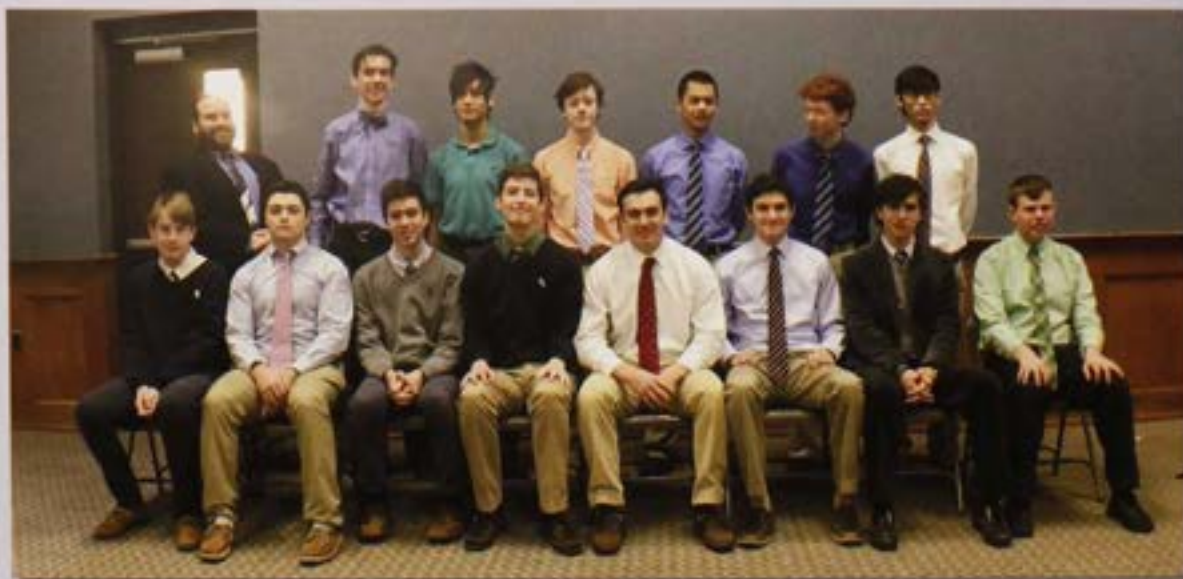
## Decorum!

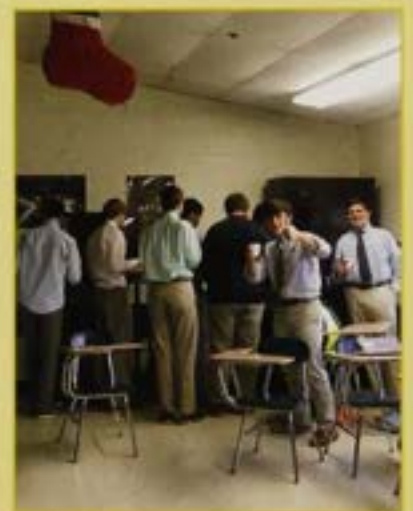
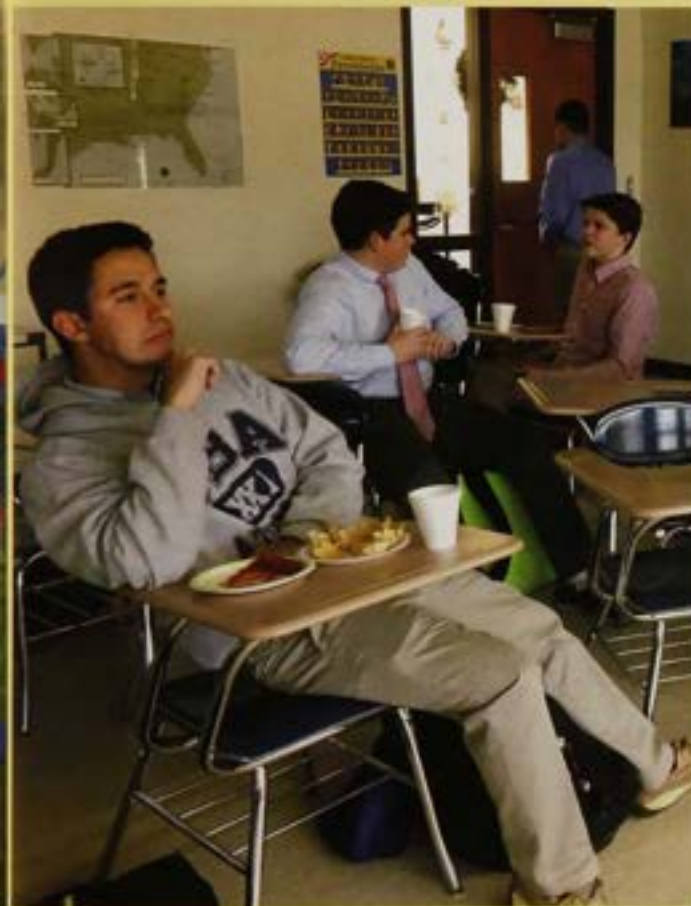
## Academy Torch
